34 If it has been determined by the Director of the Department of Finance and 35 Administration that the Department cannot continue a contract with a private 36 provider and the Director deems it necessary to utilize Department staff to

provide the required services, the Department is allowed, after seeking prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, to utilize the contingent positions for data entry contained in this Section and make the appropriate transfers from the various Maintenance and Operations, Professional Fees and Services or Data Processing line items contained in Section 3 of this Act to Regular Salaries and Personal Services Matching.

8 SECTION 14. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. SECTION 15. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 18 19 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 20 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 21 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 22 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 23 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 24 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 25 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 26

27 SECTION 16. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 28 29 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 30 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2011 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 31 32 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the 33 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2011 could work irreparable harm 34 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 35 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 36 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
