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11 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 12 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SUMMER 13 SCHOOL EMPLOYEES. Employees who, in addition to working during the regular 14 school term, also work during summer months shall be authorized as additional 15 compensation an amount not to exceed 1/12 of their annual salary for each 16 month or part thereof worked. Such additional compensation shall not be 17 construed as exceeding the maximum salary authorized for said employees. 18 Payment of additional compensation shall be limited to employees in the

31 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 32 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL 33 ALLOWANCE. The Arkansas Schools for the Deaf and Blind may make special 34 allowances available to any employee who performs one of the following duties 35 in addition to their normal duties:

36

1) Teaching adult education classes, parent training, student tutorial

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1 services on weekends or evenings 2 2) Coaching one or more sports 3 3) Sponsoring a club or organization that involves additional hours 4 outside of the normal working day 5 4) Interpretive Services 6 Compensation for additional duties may not exceed \$3,500 per school 7 term for any one employee during each fiscal year. Such additional 8 compensation shall not be construed as exceeding the maximum salary 9 authorized for said employee. 10 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 11 2010 2011 through June 30, 2011 2012. 12 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 13 14 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 15 ADDITIONAL SALARY/COMPENSATION PROVISION. No employee drawing a salary or 16 other form of compensation from the Arkansas Schools for the Deaf or Blind 17 shall be paid an additional salary or receive additional compensation, other 18 than reimbursement for actual expenses, from that agency, nor from any other 19 agency or institution of higher education, except from the Superintendent's 20 written certification to and approval by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the 21 State that the work performed by the employee for the other position does not 22 interfere with the proper and required performance of the employee's primary 23 duties, and that the combined salary payments from both positions will not 24 exceed the maximum annual salary for whichever of the two positions has the 25 higher authorized maximum annual salary. 26 Any employee knowingly violating the provisions of this section shall

26 Any employee knowingly violating the provisions of this section shall 27 be subject to immediate termination and shall be barred from employment by 28 any agency or institution of the State of Arkansas for a period of not less 29 than three (3) years or until such employee shall repay to the State of 30 Arkansas any sums received by such employee in violation of this section, 31 together with interest at a rate of ten percent (10%) per annum.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
2010 2011 through June 30, 2011 2012.

35 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 36 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SHIFT

DIFFERENTIAL. For Arkansas School for the Deaf, shift work must begin not
 earlier than 2:00 p.m. and end no later than 8:00 a.m. the following day.
 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
 2010 2011 through June 30, 2011 2012.

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6 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 7 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CERTIFIED 8 MASTERS OR BACHELOR TEACHERS ENTERING STATE SERVICE. Upon the 9 superintendent's certification to the State Personnel Administrator of prior 10 service at an educational institution, the salary of teachers entering state 11 service as teachers may be adjusted to a rate of pay closest to but not less 12 than the annual salary they would have received from their previous employer, 13 effective upon employment at ASD.

14 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 15 <u>2010</u> <u>2011</u> through June 30, 2011 <u>2012</u>.

16

17 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 18 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 19 PROVISION. Upon approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the 20 Arkansas School for the Deaf shall transfer appropriation from the 21 Miscellaneous Activities line item in this Act, to Item No. (01) through Item 22 No. (05) in Section 3 of this Act, to compensate staff who work during the 23 summer months on summer projects and to cover other expenses of summer 24 project activities. The Miscellaneous Activities line item may also be used 25 for the annual cost related to the payment of contracted interpreter 26 services, compensation of eligible staff for shift differential pay, and 27 compensation of employees for performance of duties assigned as referenced in 28 Section 7 of this Act. Such additional compensation shall not be construed 29 as exceeding the maximum salary authorized for said employees.

30 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
31 2010 2011 through June 30, 2011 2012.

32

33 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 34 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
 35 MAINTENANCE/TRANSPORTATION/SECURITY. The Arkansas School for the Deaf shall
 36 be responsible for providing maintenance, transportation, and security for

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the Arkansas School for the Blind. The Arkansas School for the Deaf is
 authorized to spend general revenue funds to provide for these services.
 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
 2010 2011 through June 30, 2011 2012.

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6 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 7 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SHARED 8 SERVICES. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and the State Treasurer are 9 authorized to establish a joint paying account in the State Treasury, upon 10 direction of the Board of Trustees for the Arkansas School for the Blind and 11 the Arkansas School for the Deaf. The Board may transfer positions, funds 12 and appropriations to the paying account from either school to serve both 13 schools in the areas of Accounting, Personnel, Inventory, Safety and Health 14 Services.

15 Funding and appropriations for this account will be from transfers from 16 the fund accounts and appropriations of each agency and shall be divided 17 proportionately from each agency based on student population. Said funds 18 shall be payable from the joint account as if the positions and other 19 budgetary line items of appropriation had originally been established in the 20 joint account. Supervision of this account and supervision of the positions 21 within may come from either school as determined by the Board of Trustees. 22 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 23 2010 2011 through June 30, 2011 2012.

24

25 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 26 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TEACHER 27 SALARY INCREASE. In the event that an act is enacted in which the public 28 schools receive funds from the General Assembly to raise the salaries of 29 teachers employed in the public school districts, the Arkansas School for the 30 Deaf and the Arkansas School for the Blind shall be included.

31 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 32 2010 2011 through June 30, 2011 2012.

33

34 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 35 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL 36 RATES OF PAY. Due to the need to meet the minimum compensation schedule as

established by Act 74 of the 2nd Extraordinary Session of the 84th General
 Assembly, or its successor, for public school teachers, counselors, and
 librarians and other education professionals as listed in subsection (a)
 below, the Arkansas School for the Deaf is authorized to adjust current or
 new employees to at least the minimum level of compensation for public school
 employees.

For current or new employees in the positions listed in subsection (a) below, the Arkansas School for the Deaf may implement salary adjustments to maintain equity between their teacher salaries and those of Central Arkansas Public School Systems only after a plan for determining and implementing those adjustments has been reviewed by the Office of Personnel Management and by the Personnel Committee of the Arkansas Legislative Council and approved by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State.

14 For purposes of implementing the plan, the Arkansas School for the Deaf 15 is authorized special rates of pay up to the maximum of the assigned grade 16 for classifications listed in subsection (a) below.

27 Funding for the minimum compensation provided for in this section that is supported in whole or in part from general revenues, shall, if required, 28 29 be provided by a transfer from the Merit Adjustment Fund to the proper fund 30 or fund account and in such amounts as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer 31 of the State. The Arkansas School for the Deaf shall, in addition to the 32 funds provided in this Act for Annual Career Service Recognition Payments 33 from the Merit Adjustment Fund, make available any funding generated from 34 agency salary savings for such purposes from the funds or fund accounts as 35 provided by law.

36

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,

1 <u>2010</u> <u>2011</u> through June 30, <u>2011</u> <u>2012</u>.

3	SECTION 16. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
4	authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
5	and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
6	the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
7	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
8	Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
9	control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
10	the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
11	strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.
12	
13	SECTION 17. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
14	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
15	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
16	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
17	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
18	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
19	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
20	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
21	
22	SECTION 18. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
23	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
24	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
25	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2011 is essential to the operation of
26	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
27	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
28	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2011 could work irreparable harm
29	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
30	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
31	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
32	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2011.
