19 SECTION 24. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 20 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 21 PROVISION. In the event the State Insurance Department is unable to maintain 22 a full roster of examination personnel, and upon approval of the Chief Fiscal 23 Officer of the State, the resulting unused appropriations in Regular 24 Salaries, Extra Help, and Personal Services Matching may be transferred to 25 the Professional Services special line item for the purpose of contracting with qualified individuals or firms for examination assistance. 26 27 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2010

30 SECTION 25. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. 4	SECTION 26. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
5	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
6	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
7	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
8	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
9	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or

13	SECTION 27. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
14	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits

16	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2011 is essential to the operation of
17	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
18	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
19	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2011 could work irreparable harm
20	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
21	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
22	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
23	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2011.
