2	(2) A Level 4 sex offender who is assessed a late fee under		
3	subdivision (a)(1) of this section shall pay two (2) times the amount of the		
4	late fee under subdivision (a)(1) of this section.		
5	(b)(1) The local law enforcement agency having jurisdiction shall		
6	retain one-third $(1/3)$ of the fee described in this section and shall use the		
7	retained portion of the fee for law enforcement purposes designed to monitor		
8	sex offenders, notify the community of sex offenders, and verify sex		
9	offenders' addresses.		
10	(2) The remaining two-thirds (2/3) of the fee described in this		
11	section collected by the local law enforcement agency having jurisdiction		
12	shall be remitted by the tenth day of each month to the Administration of		
13	Justice Funds Section of the Office of Administrative Services of the		
14	Department of Finance and Administration on a form provided by the office for		
15	deposit into the Sex and Child Offenders Registration Fund as established by		
16	<u>§ 12-12-911.</u>
