23	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-15-303 is amended to read as follows:			
24	20-15-303. Exception.			
25	This subchapter shall not apply to any child whose parents parent or			
26	guardian objects thereto on the grounds that it conflicts with the tenets and			
27	practices of a recognized church or religious faith of which the parent or			
28	guardian is an adherent or membe r <u>on the grounds that the testing of newborn</u>			
29	infants conflicts with the religious or philosophical beliefs of the parent			
30	<u>or guardian</u> .

32	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 20-10-1305 is amended to read as follows:			
33	20-10-1305. Exemptions.			
34	All residents of nursing home facilities and all full-time and part-			
35	time employees of nursing home facilities shall be immunized according to			
36	this subchapter with the following exemptions:

(1) No individual shall be required to receive either an influenza virus vaccine or a pneumococcal pneumonia vaccine if the vaccine is medically contraindicated as described in the product labeling approved by the federal Food and Drug Administration; and (2) The provisions of this subchapter shall This subchapter does not apply if the resident or the legal guardian of the resident objects on the ground that the immunization conflicts with the religious tenets and practices of a recognized church or religious denomination of which the resident or guardian is an adherent or member with the religious or philosophical beliefs of the resident or legal guardian.
