For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT CONCERNING STATE AGENCY EMPLOYEE GRIEVANCES;
TO PROVIDE THE POSSIBILITY OF RELIEF FOR EMPLOYEES
WITH GROUNDS FOR A GRIEVANCE, INCLUDING WITHOUT
LIMITATION THE RECEIPT OF CREDIT UNDER AN APPLICABLE
RETIREMENT SYSTEM; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

AN ACT CONCERNING STATE EMPLOYEE
GRIEVANCES AND POSSIBLE RELIEF FOR
GRIEVANCES, INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION
CREDIT UNDER A RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is to amend Arkansas law concerning
state employee grievances, including without limitation providing the
possibility of relief for employees with grounds for a grievance that
includes without limitation the receipt of credit under an applicable
retirement system.
