24	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-61-301(a)-(c), concerning certification		
25	of postsecondary education institutions, is amended to read as follows:		
26	(a)(l)(A) Individuals desiring to establish a postsecondary education		
27	institution in the State of Arkansas, other than a state-supported		
28	institution, a school as defined by § 6-51-601 et seq., or a school that is		
29	<del>regulated by the State Board of Cosmetology,</del> <u>An individual</u> shall <del>be required</del>		
30	<del>to</del> incorporate under the applicable laws of the <del>State of Arkansas</del> <u>state</u> and		
31	<del>to</del> receive certification <del>for</del> <u>from the Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating</u>		
32	<u>Board before</u> offering educational <del>programs from the Arkansas Higher Education</del>		
33	<i>Coordinating Board coursework leading to a degree or before establishing a</i>		
34	postsecondary educational institution unless the institution is a:		
35	(i) State-supported institution of higher education;		
36	(ii) School under § 6-51-601 et seq.;		

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1	(iii) School exempt from § 6-61-301 et seq.; or		
2	(iv) School regulated by the State Board of		
3	<u>Cosmetology</u> .		
4	(B) Any <u>A</u> postsecondary education institution located in		
5	another state, other than those covered by § 6-51-601 et seq. or those

8	<del>offering any course work, to</del> obtain certification <del>to do so</del> from the Arkansas		
9	Higher Education Coordinating Board <u>before offering a course or degree in</u>		
10	this state unless the institution is a:		
11	(i) School under § 6-51-601 et seq.;		
12	(ii) School exempt from § 6-61-301 et seq.; or		
13	(iii) School regulated by the State Board of		
14	<u>Cosmetology</u> .		
15	(C) Any <u>A</u> postsecondary education institution in <del>the State</del>		
16	<del>of Arkansas</del> <u>this state</u> <del>desiring to offer programs leading to a degree that is</del>		
17	<del>customarily granted by colleges or universities</del> shall <del>be required to</del> <u>first</u>		
18	obtain certification <del>to grant such degree</del> from the Arkansas Higher Education		
19	Coordinating Board before offering courses that lead to a degree that is		
20	customarily granted by colleges or universities.		
21	(2) State-supported vocational and technical schools,		
22	institutions covered under § $6-51-601$ et seq., or institutions regulated by		
23	the State Board of Cosmetology shall <del>be required to</del> obtain approval for		
24	programs in which <del>such degrees would</del> <u>a degree could</u> be granted from both the		
25	Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board and the State Board of

27	(3) Nonpublic, not-for-profit colleges and universities		
28	currently incorporated, recognized by the Arkansas Higher Education

14	<u>development period; or</u>		
15	(D) An applicant for accreditation from an entity		
16	recognized by the United States Department of Education or the Council for		
17	Higher Education Accreditation during the institutional planning and		
18	development application process.		
19	(c) Any person violating the provisions of <u>An individual or</u>		
20	postsecondary institution that operates in the state without certification		
21	from the Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board as required under		
22	<del>subdivision (a)(l)(B) or (C) or </del> subsection <del>(b)<u>(</u>a)</del> of this section shall be		
23	guilty of a Class B misdemeanor.
