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SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 3 4 PROVISION. Upon approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the 5 Arkansas School for the Blind shall transfer appropriation from Item No. (08) 6 Summer Projects, in Section 3 of this Act, to Item No. (01) through Item No. 7 (05) in Section 3 of this Act, to compensate staff who work during the summer 8 months on summer projects, and to cover other expenses of summer project 9 The Summer Projects line item may also be used for the annual 10 cost related to the compensation of eligible staff for shift differential pay 11 as well as compensation of employees for performance of duties assigned as 12 referenced in Section 8 of this Act. 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- SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL ALLOWANCE. The Arkansas Schools for the Deaf and Blind may make special allowances available to any employee who performs one of the following duties in addition to their normal duties:
- 1) Teaching adult education classes, parent training, student tutorial services on weekends or evenings
 - 2) Coaching one or more sports
 - 3) Sponsoring a club or organization that involves additional hours outside of the normal working day
 - 4) Interpretive Services

Compensation for additional duties may not exceed \$3,500 per school term for any one employee during each fiscal year. Such pay shall not be construed as exceeding the maximum salary authorized for said position.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, $\frac{2010}{100}$ 2011 through June 30, $\frac{2011}{100}$ 2012.

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SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

ADDITIONAL SALARY/COMPENSATION PROVISION. No employee drawing a salary or

- 1 other form of compensation from the Arkansas Schools for the Deaf or Blind
- 2 shall be paid an additional salary or receive additional compensation, other
- 3 than reimbursement for actual expenses, from that agency, nor from any other
- 4 agency or institution of higher education, except from the Superintendent's
- 5 written certification to and approval by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
- 6 State that the work performed by the employee for the other position does not
- 7 interfere with the proper and required performance of the employee's primary
- 8 duties, and that the combined salary payments from both positions will not
- 9 exceed the maximum annual salary for whichever of the two positions has the
- 10 higher authorized maximum annual salary.
- 11 Any employee knowingly violating the provisions of this section shall
- 12 be subject to immediate termination and shall be barred from employment by
- 13 any agency or institution of the State of Arkansas for a period of not less

- 16 together with interest at a rate of ten percent (10%) per annum.

Due to the need to meet the minimum compensation schedule as 20 established by Act 74 of the 2nd Extraordinary Session of the 84th General 21 Assembly, or its successor, for public school teachers, counselors, and 22 librarians and other education professionals as listed in subsection (a) 23
- below, the Arkansas School for the Blind is authorized to adjust current or 24 new employees to at least the minimum level of compensation for public school 25 employees. 26 For current or new employees in the positions listed in subsection (a)

Funding for the minimum compensation provided for in this section that is supported in whole or in part from general revenues, shall, if required, be provided by a transfer from the Merit Adjustment Fund to the proper fund or fund account and in such amounts as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer The Arkansas School for the Blind shall, in addition to the of the State. funds provided in this Act for Annual Career Service Recognition Payments from the Merit Adjustment Fund, make available any funding generated from agency salary savings for such purposes from the funds or fund accounts as provided by law.

SECTION 16. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 17. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget

T	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
2	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
3	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
4	
5	SECTION 18. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
6	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
7	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
8	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2011 is essential to the operation of
9	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
10	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
11	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2011 could work irreparable harm
12	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
13	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
14	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
15	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2011.
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
