11 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. 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6 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 7 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. INTER-AGENCY TRANSFER OF STATE GENERAL REVENUE FOR THE TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE FOR 8 9 NEEDY FAMILIES (TANF) PROGRAMS. Upon the request of the Director of the 10 Department of Human Services and the Director of the Department of Workforce 11 Services (DWS), the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State may approve up to 12 \$3,640,650 in State General Revenue appropriated to DWS for the TANF Program 13 to be transferred to the Department of Human Services - Division of County 14 Operations in support of Arkansas' Temporary Assistance for Needy Families 15 (TANF) Programs or any related Separate State Programs. The Director of the 16 Department of Workforce Services shall provide a report of all transfers made 17 to the DHS - Division of County Operations to the Performance Evaluation and 18 Expenditure Review Committee of the Arkansas Legislative Council and/or Joint 19 Budget Committee. The report must include the justification for and the 20 amount of the completed transfers.

21 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2010
22 <u>2011</u> through June 30, 2011 <u>2012</u>.

24 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 25 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. DIVISION 26 OF COUNTY OPERATIONS - STATE AND FEDERAL DISASTER DECLARATIONS. It will be 27 permissible for the Division of County Operations to implement the following 28 exemptions in the event that a State or Federal Disaster is declared: (1) 29 Exceed the 240 hour per quarter limit on the purchase of temporary help; and, 30 (2) Waive the 1,000 hour limit per State Fiscal Year for Extra Help 31 positions.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2010
2011 through June 30, 2011 2012.

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35 SECTION 11. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds36 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

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and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

9 SECTION 12. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 10 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 11 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 12 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 13 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 14 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 15 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 16 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 17

SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 18 19 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 20 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2011 is essential to the operation of 21 22 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 23 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the 24 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2011 could work irreparable harm 25 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 26 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 27 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2011. 28 29 30 31 32 33

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
