36	The governing body	of a city may, by resolution	, appoint, remove, and	



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appoint successors to the position of director of the department of public safety, who shall be the chief executive officer of the department. However,

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3 in a city with a city manager form of government, the governing body may, by

4 ordinance, empower either the city manager or the civil service commission to

5 appoint, remove, and appoint successors to the position of director of the

6 department of public safety. The director of the department of public safety

7 <u>shall be appointed and removed under 14-42-110.</u>

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9 10 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 14-42-404 is amended to read as follows: 14-42-404. Functions of employees.

Employees of the department of public safety may perform the functions of police officers, fire fighters, or other services the department may be empowered to undertake if the employee is qualified under standards adopted by the governing body of the city to perform these functions <u>and holds any</u> required state certifications.

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17 SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 14-42-410 is amended to read as follows: 18 14-42-410. Creation in certain other cities and transfer. 19 (a)(1) The governing body of any city having a population, according to the 1970 Federal Decennial Census, of at least twenty-one thousand 20 21 (21,000) but less than twenty four thousand (24,000) may, by ordinance, 22 create a department of public safety. 23 (2) The department of public safety shall consist of a fire 24 division and a public safety division. 25 (b) Upon the creation of the department: 26 The existing police department shall be abolished and (1)27 transferred to the public safety division; and 28 (2) The existing fire department shall be abolished and 29 transferred to the fire division.

30 (c)(1) The officers of the public safety division shall have the 31 duties and authority of law enforcement officers and shall also perform fire 32 fighting duties as directed by the executive officer director of the public 33 safety division department, the chief executive officer of the city or town, 34 or the governing body of the city or town as allowed by law.

8	service system law in § 14-51-301 et seq. shall hereafter be appointed as		
9	prescribed by § 14-51-301 et seq. Unless the ordinance creating the		
10	department of public safety states the civil service commission of the city		
11	will be retained if in existence, then the civil service commission of the		
12	city shall be abolished upon the creation of the department of public safety.

16	(a) All employees of the department of public safety who were subject		
17	to the civil service system at the time of their employment by the department		
18	shall remain subject to the system.

20	shall be so construed as to reduce any right which any member of the existing		
21	fire department or police department may have under any civil service or		
22	retirement system.

27	(a) Except as provided in § 14-42-413, the director of the department		
28	of public safety and members of the public safety division, to be known as		
29	public safety officers, shall participate in the policemen's pension and		
30	relief fund.		
31	(b) Personnel of the fire division shall participate in the firemen's		
32	relief and pension fund.		
33	(c) This section does not reduce the rights that any member of an		
34	existing fire or police department has under any retirement system.		
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36	SECTION 8. Arkansas Code § 14-42-421 is repealed.		

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1	14-42-421. Second class cities and towns - Creation - Functions.			
2	(a) The governing body of any city of the second class or incorporated			
3	town, may, by ordinance, create a department of public safety.			
4	(b) A city or town department of public safety shall perform the			
5	functions of, and have all the rights, responsibilities, and duties of, a			
6	police department or the city or town marshal's office and a municipal fire			
7	department. Further, it may perform any other departmental functions deemed			
8	by the governing body of the city or town to be necessary for the public			
9	safety of its citizens including, but not limited to, emergency medical			
10	services, ambulance services, or building and health code enforcement.			
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12	SECTION 9. Arkansas Code § 14-42-422 is repealed.			
13	14-42-422. Cities of the second class and towns — Director — Transfer			
14	of existing departments.			
15	(a) Once the department is formed, the mayors in cities of the second			
16	<del>class and incorporated towns shall have the power to appoint and remove the</del>			
17	director of the department of public safety, unless the city or town council			
18	shall, by a two-thirds (2/3) majority of the total membership of the council,			
19	vote to override the mayor's action.			
20	(b) Upon the creation of the department, the existing police			
21	department or the city or town marshal's office and the existing fire			
22	department shall be abolished and transferred to the department of public			
23	safety.			
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25	SECTION 10. Arkansas Code § 14-42-423 is repealed.

27	Employees of the department of public safety may perform the functions			
28	of police officers, fire fighters, or other services the department may be			
29	empowered to undertake if the particular employee is qualified under			
30	standards adopted by the governing body of the city to perform these			
31	functions and is in compliance with and qualified or certified by the			
32	applicable state laws.			
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34	SECTION 11. Arkansas Code § 14-42-424 is repealed.			
35	14-42-424. Cities of the second class and towns - Employee benefits			

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1	(a) For the purposes of regulating work hours, vacation days, sick
2	leave, and other employee benefits, a department of public safety shall be
3	deemed to be a fire department.
4	(b) A department of public safety may participate in available pension
5	programs in either the police or fire category, or both, and conditioned on
6	their creation and availability within the particular city or town. However,
7	no employee of the department shall accrue benefits in both categories at the
8	same time.
9	(c) Volunteers for fire services provided by the department of public
10	safety may accrue benefits as volunteer fire fighters.
11	(d) Employees of a department of public safety shall be eligible for
12	all county, state, or federal death or disability benefits provided for
13	police officers or fire fighters.
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15	SECTION 12. Arkansas Code § 14-42-425 is repealed.
16	14-42-425. Cities of the second class and towns — Grants — Applicable
17	regulations and laws.
18	(a) A department of public safety shall be entitled to all available
19	county, state, and federal grants, turnback money, insurance premium tax
20	funds, loans, discounts, or other benefits of a similar nature available to
21	police or fire departments for training or equipment.
22	(b) All applicable regulations and statutes regulating the
23	certification of law enforcement officers, the certification of fire
24	departments, the conduct of police or fire departments or their functions
25	shall apply to a department of public safety and its employees.
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
