21	SECTION 1. Ari	cansas Code § 2-36-302(a) and (b), concerning the
22	permanent location of	the Northeast Arkansas District Fair, are amended to
23	read as follows:	
24	(a)(1) There	is created the Northeast Arkansas District Fair Advisory
25	Board to be composed	of thirty-one (31) the following members:

2	(J) Two (2) members from Independence County;	
3	(K) One (1) member from Lawrence County;	
4	(L)(K) One (1) member from Randolph County;	
5	(M)(L) One (1) member from Lee County;	
6	$\frac{(N)}{(M)}$ One (1) member from Woodruff County; and	
7	$\frac{\text{(O)}(\text{N})}{\text{Three}}$ Three (3) members One (1) member from White County.	
8	(2)(A) The county fair board of each county shall select the	
9	person from that county to be a member of the Northeast Arkansas District	
10	Fair Advisory Board.	
11	(B) If any county does not have a county fair board, the	
12	county judge of that county shall appoint that county's representative to the	
13	board Northeast Arkansas District Fair Advisory Board.	
14	(C)(i) There is created an executive board that shall be	
15	comprised of the members of the county fair board of the county in which the	
16	Northeast Arkansas District Fair is located.	
17	(ii) The executive board shall be responsible for	
18	the day-to-day operations and maintenance of the Northeast Arkansas District	
19	Fair fairgrounds.	
20	(3) Members of the <del>board</del> <u>Northeast Arkansas District Fair</u>	
21	Advisory Board shall serve four-year terms, and any vacancies arising in the	
22	<del>board</del> Northeast Arkansas District Fair Advisory Board membership shall be

24	(b)(1) In all matters, the fair shall be subject to the rules and

34	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the	
35	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that Independence County has made	
36	the decision to move to a different district fair; that the Northeast

1	Arkansas District Fair needs to be able to ensure that its operations		
2	continue to run in an efficient manner; and that this act is immediately		
3	necessary because the Northeast Arkansas District Fair Board and executive		
4	board need to be able to make the necessary preparations and advise the		
5	participants, vendors, and community of changes in a timely manner.		
6	Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately		
7	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall		
8	become effective on:		
9	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
10	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
11	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
12	bill; or		
13	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
14	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
