The Department of Information 8 Systems will maintain documentation for projects billed for these purposes. 9 Fund transfers may be made from the General Revenue Fund Account, upon the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and prior review of the 10 11 Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, to reimburse the 12 Department of Information Systems for the amounts billed.

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14 SECTION 77. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 15 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. WORK 16 FORCE 2000 DISTRIBUTION. After the amounts to be made available to the 17 various technical institutes or comprehensive lifelong learning centers have 18 been determined as set out in Arkansas Code 26-51-205(d)(2), such documents 19 as may be necessary shall be processed so that funds may be transferred from 20 the Work Force 2000 Development Fund to the State Treasury fund or fund 21 account from which the technical institute or comprehensive lifelong learning 22 center draws its general revenue support. Such funds as may be transferred 23 shall not exceed 6.309% of the total funds available from the Work Force 2000 24 Development Fund during each fiscal year.

25 In the event that a technical college, community college or educational 26 institution which receives support from the Work Force 2000 Development Fund 27 as determined by law transfers from the Arkansas Technical College and 28 Community College System for which Work Force 2000 Development Fund monies 29 are determined by law, then the actual amount of support from the Work Force 30 2000 Development Fund in the preceding fiscal year for such educational 31 institution shall be made available irrespective of any other provision of 32 law which sets out maximum levels of support from such fund.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
2010 2011 through June 30, 2011 2012.

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SECTION 78. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

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1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. DISBURSED GENERAL IMPROVEMENT FUNDS - ACT 638 OF 2001. If a county has 2 unexpended grant funds awarded from the Eighty-Third Session Projects Account 3 4 of the General Improvement Fund on the effective date of this act for the 5 purpose of establishing a community center, the county may use the grant 6 funds to fund the construction of park improvements in the community for 7 which the county is holding the grant funds. 8 9 SECTION 79. APPROPRIATION - LIGNITE DRILLING, TESTING, AND REPORTING. 10 There is herby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration 11 - Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its 12 successor fund or fund accounts, the following: 13 (A) for a grant to the Arkansas Geological Survey for professional 14 services, maintenance, general operating expenses, and matching funds for 15 drilling and testing lignite core samples and reporting of the findings, in a 16 sum not to exceed......\$2,500,000. 17 SECTION 80. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 18 19 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 20 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 21 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 22 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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SECTION 81. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 28 29 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 30 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 31 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 32 33 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 34 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 35 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 36

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1	SECTION 82. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
2	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
3	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
4	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2011 is essential to the operation of
5	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
6	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
7	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2011 could work irreparable harm
8	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
9	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
10	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
11	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2011.
