13 AN ACT FOR THE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER
14 EDUCATION REAPPROPRIATION.
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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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20 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS NORTHEASTERN COLLEGE. There is
21 hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Northeastern College, to be payable from
22 the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the
23 Arkansas Northeastern College the following:

24 (A) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
25 in Item (D) Section 1 of Act 255 of 2010, for construction of a Nursing and
26 Allied Health building, in a sum not to exceed.....\$1,000,000.

27 (B) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
28 in Item (E) Section 1 of Act 255 of 2010, for deferred maintenance, in a sum
29 not to exceed.....\$75,000.

30 (C) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
31 in Item (F) Section 1 of Act 255 of 2010, for replacement/renewal of
32 equipment and library holdings, in a sum not to exceed.....\$50,000.

33 (D) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
34 in Item (C) Section 1 of Act 255 of 2010, for construction, renovation, major
35 maintenance, maintenance, and purchase of equipment, in a sum not to exceed
36\$500,000.

2 structures or objects, in a sum not to exceed.....\$248,292.

27 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
28 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
29 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
30 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
31 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
32 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
33 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
34 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

35 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State
36 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the

1 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of

7 SECTION 24. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
8 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
9 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
10 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
11 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
12 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
13 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
14 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

15
16 SECTION 25. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
17 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
18 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
19 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2011 is essential to the operation of
20 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
21 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
22 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2011 could work irreparable harm
23 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
24 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
25 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
26 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2011.
