AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL
IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE STATE MILITARY
DEPARTMENT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

AN ACT FOR THE STATE MILITARY DEPARTMENT
REAPPROPRIATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - FEDERAL FUNDS. There is hereby
appropriated, to the State Military Department, to be payable from the
federal funds as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for the
State Military Department the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
in Item (B) Section 2 of Act 105 of 2010, for construction and related
expenses for a Centralized Vehicle Wash Facility for cleaning heavy/tracked
vehicles, to provide vehicle maintenance f.....\$1,065,500.

(B) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
in Item (O) Section 1 of Act 105 of 2010, for construction of a Cabot Armory,
in a sum not to exceed.....\$5,477,916.

(C) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
in Item (T) Section 1 of Act 105 of 2010, for construction of a Combined
Support Maintenance Shop at Camp Robinson, in a sum not to exceed
.....\$31,825,907.

(D) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
in Item (Y) Section 1 of Act 105 of 2010, for construction of a Camden



1 Readiness Center, in a sum not to exceed.....\$9,974,277.

2 (E) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
3 in Item (AA) Section 1 of Act 105 of 2010, for the Armory Rehabilitation
4 Project Phase III for major maintenance, renovation and repair projects for
5 State Armories, in a sum not to exceed.....\$10,000,000.

6 (F) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
7 in Item (CC) Section 1 of Act 105 of 2010, for renovations to comply with ADA
8 requirements, in a sum not to exceed.....\$750,000.

9 (G) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
10 in Item (FF) Section 1 of Act 105 of 2010, for construction of the Northwest
11 Arkansas Armed Forces Reserve Center, in a sum not to exceed
12\$9,328,607.

13 (H) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
14 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 105 of 2010, for construction of the Regional
15 Training Institute Phase II, in a sum not to exceed.....\$34,321,930.

16 (I) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
17 in Item (B) Section 1 of Act 105 of 2010, for construction of the Searcy
18 Field Maintenance Shop, in a sum not to exceed.....\$7,407,510.

19 (J) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
20 in Item (C) Section 1 of Act 105 of 2010, for construction of the Fort
21 Chaffee Combined Army Collective Training Facility, in a sum not to
22 exceed.....\$26,481,358.

23 (K) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
24 in Item (D) Section 1 of Act 105 of 2010, for construction of the Fort
25 Chaffee Convoy Live Fire/Entry Control Point, in a sum not to
26 exceed.....\$4,486,004.

27 (L) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
28 in Item (E) Section 1 of Act 105 of 2010, for construction and renovation of
29 the CMTC (Chaffee Maneuver Training Center) Sewer Collection System, in a sum
30 not to exceed.....\$3,220,223.

31 (M) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
32 in Item (F) Section 1 of Act 105 of 2010, for construction of the West
33 Memphis Armory, in a sum not to exceed.....\$6,039,152.

34 (N) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
35 in Item (G) Section 1 of Act 105 of 2010, for construction of the Fort
36 Chaffee Infantry Platoon Battle Course, in a sum not to exceed

.....\$3,926,000.

(O) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (H) Section 1 of Act 105 of 2010, for construction of the Fort Chaffee Infantry Squad Battle Course, in a sum not to exceed

.....\$6,166,000.

(P) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (I) Section 1 of Act 105 of 2010, for construction of the Convoy Live Fire/Entry Control Point, in a sum not to exceed.....\$4,430,000.

(Q) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (J) Section 1 of Act 105 of 2010, for construction and renovation projects for Camp Robinson, in a sum not to exceed.....\$3,000,000.

SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated, to the State Military Department, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the State Military Department the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) Section 4 of Act 105 of 2010, for construction, major maintenance, repairs, asphalt paving and associated expenses at various National Guard Armories including, Warren, Mountain Home, West Memphis and an Aviation Armory at Camp Robinson, in a sum not to exceed.....\$413,002.

(B) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) Section 4 of Act 105 of 2010, for critically needed maintenance for National Guard Armories state-wide for the State Military Department, in a sum not to exceed.....\$123,632.

(C) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (D) Section 4 of Act 105 of 2010, for the rehabilitation of National Guard Armories throughout the State to ensure combat and State emergency readiness, in a sum not to exceed.....\$30,550.

(D) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (E) Section 4 of Act 105 of 2010, for renovations to comply with ADA requirements, in a sum not to exceed.....\$750,000.

(E) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (F) Section 4 of Act 105 of 2010, for the Armory Rehabilitation Project Phase III for major maintenance, renovation and repair projects for State Armories, in a sum not to exceed.....\$10,000,000.

(F) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (G) Section 4 of Act 105 of 2010, for construction and renovation of the Civilian Student Training Program's Training and Activity Center, in a sum not to exceed.....\$500,000.

(G) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (H) Section 4 of Act 105 of 2010, for renovations to comply with ADA requirements, in a sum not to exceed.....\$750,000.

(H) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (I) Section 4 of Act 105 of 2010, for construction of the West Memphis Armory, in a sum not to exceed.....\$2,013,051.

(I) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (J) Section 4 of Act 105 of 2010, for providing matching funds for Federal monies for construction projects for Camp Robinson, in a sum not to exceed.....\$3,000,000.

(J) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (K) Section 4 of Act 105 of 2010, for major maintenance, repair and rehabilitation for Armories, in a sum not to exceed.....\$2,000,000.

SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - MISCELLANEOUS REVENUE. There is hereby appropriated, to the State Military Department, to be payable from the Armory Construction Fund, for the State Military Department the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) Section 5 of Act 105 of 2010, for repair, construction, renovation, landscaping and maintenance of armories, hangars, and other properties held for the use and benefit of the Arkansas National Guard, in a sum not to exceed.....\$128,292.

SECTION 4. REAPPROPRIATION - NCRC GRANT. There is hereby appropriated, to the State Military Department, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and Cultural Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the State Military Department the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided in Section 30 of Act 237 of 2010, for a Global War on Terrorism Permanent Exhibit, in a sum not to exceed.....\$92,071.

SECTION 5. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor

1 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
2 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
3 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
4 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
5 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
6 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
7 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
8 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
9 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
10 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
11 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

12 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State
13 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the
14 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of
15 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
16 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
17 disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided
18 otherwise by law.

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20 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
21 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
22 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
23 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
24 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
25 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
26 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
27 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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29 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
30 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
31 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
32 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2011 is essential to the operation of
33 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
34 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
35 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2011 could work irreparable harm
36 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental

1 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
2 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
3 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2011.
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
