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13	SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT FUNDS. There is
14	hereby appropriated, to the State Military Department, to be payable from the
15	General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the
16	State Military Department the following:
17	(A) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
18	in Item (A) Section 4 of Act 105 of 2010, for construction, major
19	maintenance, repairs, asphalt paving and associated expenses at various
20	National Guard Armories including, Warren, Mountain Home, West Memphis and an
21	Aviation Armory at Camp Robinson, in a sum not to exceed\$413,002.
22	(B) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
23	in Item (B) Section 4 of Act 105 of 2010, for critically needed maintenance
24	for National Guard Armories state-wide for the State Military Department, in
25	a sum not to exceed\$123,632.
26	(C) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
27	in Item (D) Section 4 of Act 105 of 2010, for the rehabilitation of National
28	Guard Armories throughout the State to ensure combat and State emergency
29	readiness, in a sum not to exceed\$30,550.
30	(D) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided

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19	SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - MISCELLANEOUS REVENUE. There is hereby
20	appropriated, to the State Military Department, to be payable from the Armory
21	Construction Fund, for the State Military Department the following:
22	(A) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
23	in Item (A) Section 5 of Act 105 of 2010, for repair, construction,
24	renovation, landscaping and maintenance of armories, hangars, and other
25	properties held for the use and benefit of the Arkansas National Guard, in a
26	sum not to exceed\$128,292.
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28	SECTION 4. REAPPROPRIATION - NCRC GRANT. There is hereby appropriated,
29	to the State Military Department, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and
30	Cultural Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the State Military Department
31	the following:
32	(A) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
33	in Section 30 of Act 237 of 2010, for a Global War on Terrorism Permanent
34	Exhibit, in a sum not to exceed\$92,071.
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36	SECTION 5. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor

- l obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
- 2 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
- 3 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
- 4 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
- 5 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
- 6 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
- 7 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
- 8 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
- 9 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
- 10 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
- 11 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.
- 12 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State
- 13 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the
- 14 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of
- 15 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
- 16 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
- 17 disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided
- 18 otherwise by law.

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20 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General

21 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations

22 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for

23 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive

24 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget

25 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or

26 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative

27 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

- SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
- 30 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
- 31 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
- 32 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2011 is essential to the operation of
- 33 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
- 34 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
- 35 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2011 could work irreparable harm
- 36 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
