8 AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL
9 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE STATE MILITARY
10 DEPARTMENT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.
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13 **Subtitle**

14 AN ACT FOR THE STATE MILITARY DEPARTMENT
15 REAPPROPRIATION.
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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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20 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - FEDERAL FUNDS. There is hereby
21 appropriated, to the State Military Department, to be payable from the
22 federal funds as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for the
23 State Military Department the following:

24 (A) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
25 in Item (B) Section 2 of Act 105 of 2010, for construction and related
26 expenses for a Centralized Vehicle Wash Facility for cleaning heavy/tracked
27 vehicles, to provide vehicle *maintenance for mechanized or tracked units and*
28 *related services, in a sum not to exceed.....\$1,065,500.*

29 (B) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
30 in Item (O) Section 1 of Act 105 of 2010, for construction of a Cabot Armory,
31 in a sum not to exceed.....\$5,477,916.

32 (C) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
33 in Item (T) Section 1 of Act 105 of 2010, for construction of a Combined
34 Support Maintenance Shop at Camp Robinson, in a sum not to exceed
35\$31,825,907.

36 (D) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided



1 in Item (Y) Section 1 of Act 105 of 2010, for construction of a Camden
2 Readiness Center, in a sum not to exceed.....\$9,974,277.

3 (E) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
4 in Item (AA) Section 1 of Act 105 of 2010, for the Armory Rehabilitation
5 Project Phase III for major maintenance, renovation and repair projects for
6 State Armories, in a sum not to exceed.....\$10,000,000.

7 (F) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
8 in Item (CC) Section 1 of Act 105 of 2010, for renovations to comply with ADA
9 requirements, in a sum not to exceed.....\$750,000.

10 (G) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
11 in Item (FF) Section 1 of Act 105 of 2010, for construction of the Northwest
12 Arkansas Armed Forces Reserve Center, in a sum not to exceed
13\$9,328,607.

14 (H) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
15 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 105 of 2010, for construction of the Regional
16 Training Institute Phase II, in a sum not to exceed.....\$34,321,930.

17 (I) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
18 in Item (B) Section 1 of Act 105 of 2010, for construction of the Searcy
19 Field Maintenance Shop, in a sum not to exceed.....\$7,407,510.

20 (J) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
21 in Item (C) Section 1 of Act 105 of 2010, for construction of the Fort
22 Chaffee Combined Army Collective Training Facility, in a sum not to
23 exceed.....\$26,481,358.

24 (K) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
25 in Item (D) Section 1 of Act 105 of 2010, for construction of the Fort
26 Chaffee Convoy Live Fire/Entry Control Point, in a sum not to
27 exceed.....\$4,486,004.

28 (L) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
29 in Item (E) Section 1 of Act 105 of 2010, for construction and renovation of
30 the CMTC (Chaffee Maneuver Training Center) Sewer Collection System, in a sum
31 not to exceed.....\$3,220,223.

32 (M) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
33 in Item (F) Section 1 of Act 105 of 2010, for construction of the West
34 Memphis Armory, in a sum not to exceed.....\$6,039,152.

35 (N) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
36 in Item (G) Section 1 of Act 105 of 2010, for construction of the Fort

1 Chaffee Infantry Platoon Battle Course, in a sum not to exceed
2\$3,926,000.

3 (O) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
4 in Item (H) Section 1 of Act 105 of 2010, for construction of the Fort
5 Chaffee Infantry Squad Battle Course, in a sum not to exceed
6\$6,166,000.

7 (P) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
8 in Item (I) Section 1 of Act 105 of 2010, for construction of the Convoy Live
9 Fire/Entry Control Point, in a sum not to exceed.....\$4,430,000.

10 (Q) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
11 in Item (J) Section 1 of Act 105 of 2010, for construction and renovation
12 projects for Camp Robinson, in a sum not to exceed.....\$3,000,000.
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14 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT FUNDS. There is
15 hereby appropriated, to the State Military Department, to be payable from the
16 General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the
17 State Military Department the following:

18 (A) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
19 in Item (A) Section 4 of Act 105 of 2010, for construction, major
20 maintenance, repairs, asphalt paving and associated expenses at various
21 National Guard Armories including, Warren, Mountain Home, West Memphis and an
22 Aviation Armory at Camp Robinson, in a sum not to exceed.....\$413,002.

23 (B) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
24 in Item (B) Section 4 of Act 105 of 2010, for critically needed maintenance
25 for National Guard Armories state-wide for the State Military Department, in
26 a sum not to exceed.....\$123,632.

27 (C) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
28 in Item (D) Section 4 of Act 105 of 2010, for the rehabilitation of National
29 Guard Armories throughout the State to ensure combat and State emergency
30 readiness, in a sum not to exceed.....\$30,550.

31 (D) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
32 in Item (E) Section 4 of Act 105 of 2010, for renovations to comply with ADA
33 requirements, in a sum not to exceed.....\$750,000.

34 (E) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
35 in Item (F) Section 4 of Act 105 of 2010, for the Armory Rehabilitation
36 Project Phase III for major maintenance, renovation and repair projects for

1 State Armories, in a sum not to exceed.....\$10,000,000.

2 (F) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
3 in Item (G) Section 4 of Act 105 of 2010, for construction and renovation of
4 the Civilian Student Training Program's Training and Activity Center, in a
5 sum not to exceed.....\$500,000.

6 (G) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
7 in Item (H) Section 4 of Act 105 of 2010, for renovations to comply with ADA
8 requirements, in a sum not to exceed.....\$750,000.

9 (H) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
10 in Item (I) Section 4 of Act 105 of 2010, for construction of the West
11 Memphis Armory, in a sum not to exceed.....\$2,013,051.

12 (I) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
13 in Item (J) Section 4 of Act 105 of 2010, for providing matching funds for
14 Federal monies for construction projects for Camp Robinson, in a sum not to
15 exceed.....\$3,000,000.

16 (J) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
17 in Item (K) Section 4 of Act 105 of 2010, for major maintenance, repair and
18 rehabilitation for Armories, in a sum not to exceed.....\$2,000,000.

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20 SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - MISCELLANEOUS REVENUE. There is hereby
21 appropriated, to the State Military Department, to be payable from the Armory
22 Construction Fund, for the State Military Department the following:

23 (A) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
24 in Item (A) Section 5 of Act 105 of 2010, for repair, construction,
25 renovation, landscaping and maintenance of armories, hangars, and other
26 properties held for the use and benefit of the Arkansas National Guard, in a
27 sum not to exceed.....\$128,292.

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29 SECTION 4. REAPPROPRIATION - NCRC GRANT. There is hereby appropriated,
30 to the State Military Department, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and
31 Cultural Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the State Military Department
32 the following:

33 (A) Effective July 1, 2011, the balance of the appropriation provided
34 in Section 30 of Act 237 of 2010, for a Global War on Terrorism Permanent
35 Exhibit, in a sum not to exceed.....\$92,071.

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1 SECTION 5. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
2 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
3 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
4 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
5 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
6 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
7 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
8 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
9 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
10 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
11 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
12 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

13 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State
14 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the
15 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of
16 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
17 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
18 disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided
19 otherwise by law.

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21 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
22 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
23 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
24 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
25 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
26 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
27 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
28 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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30 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
31 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
32 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
33 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2011 is essential to the operation of
34 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
35 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
36 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2011 could work irreparable harm

1 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
2 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
3 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
4 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2011.
