SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 35 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COMMUNITY 36 CORRECTION PROGRAMS LINE ITEM USES. The appropriations authorized under the

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1 line item established herein for "Community Correction Programs" are to be 2 used by the Department of Community Correction for establishment and 3 operation of, to include construction, renovation, and contracting for 4 establishment and operation of, residential and non-residential community 5 correction programs such as, but not limited to, community correction 6 centers, drug, alcohol, and mental health treatments, intensive supervision, 7 restitution, and others as established and approved by the Board of 8 Corrections and as may be provided by law.

9 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
10 2010 2011 through June 30, 2011 2012.

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12 SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 13 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 14 AUTHORITY FOR UTILITY AND FUEL RATE INCREASE. In the event of a ten percent 15 (10%) increase in utility and fuel rates, the Department of Community 16 Correction is authorized to transfer from any line item in Section 3 - State 17 Operations to Operating Expense Item (04)(A) in Section 3 - State Operations 18 for support of the increase after receiving approval of the Chief Fiscal 19 Officer of the State. Prior to the utilization of the transfer authority a 20 report shall be made to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget 21 Committee including justification for the transfer and the amount of 22 transfer.

23 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 24 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year 25 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 26 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and 27 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 28 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly 29 has determined that the Department of Community Correction may operate more 30 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Community 31 Correction authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is 32 both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight 33 by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget 34 Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this 35 36 section. If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint

Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent
 jurisdiction, this entire section is void.

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SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 4 5 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COUNTY 6 JAIL INVOICE SUMMARY. The Departments of Correction and Community 7 Correction, shall at a minimum and on a fiscal year basis, prepare and post 8 on the applicable agency web site, a monthly summary of county jail 9 reimbursement invoices prepared and forwarded to each county sheriff for 10 verification by the Departments and for payment from the County Jail 11 Reimbursement Fund. In addition, the report shall include a summary of 12 invoices returned by each county for payment for previous months within the 13 fiscal year, the amounts paid, and any balances owed. Each fiscal year-end 14 report shall be maintained on the web sites for a period of no less than 15 three (3) years.

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17 SECTION 19. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 18 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 19 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 20 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 21 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 22 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 23 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 24 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 25 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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27 SECTION 20. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 28 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 29 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 30 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 31 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 32 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 33 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 34 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 35

SECTION 21. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the

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1	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
2	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
3	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2011 is essential to the operation of
4	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
5	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
6	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2011 could work irreparable harm
7	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
8	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
9	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
10	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2011.
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
