2	and scope of the college:
3	(1) upgrade skills of current employees in service area businesses and
4	industries, The recruitment of underserved populations in the CCCUA service
5	area, including but not limited to: Latinos, African Americans, Aging, and
6	Non-Traditional students,
7	(2) to combat illiteracy and English language deficiencies, The development
8	and offering of viable programs as defined by the Arkansas Department of
9	Higher Education and the deletion of programs which are not viable,
10	(3) to increase the number of skilled workers available for employments, The
11	cultivating of relationships in the community that establishes more industry
12	training and promotes economic development within the CCCUA service area,
13	(4) to provide leadership for school-to-work programs including cooperation
14	with area public schools, businesses, industries, and labor groups, and The
15	continued development of working relationships with area K-12 institutions to
16	provide concurrent enrollment, Advanced Placement, technical training, and
17	college readiness to these students,
18	(5) to provide the first two years of bacealaureate education transferable to
19	colleges and universities in the general community area of the College and
20	the State of Arkansas. The development of a comprehensive change in the way
21	the college prepares students for college-level work, including the
22	development of special mastery learning programs within remedial math and
23	English courses,
24	(6) The continued expansion of campus facilities to accommodate continued
25	record growth in credit and non-credit programs.
26	The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
27	2010 <u>2011</u> through June 30, 2011 <u>2012</u> .
28	
29	SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
30	authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
31	and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
32	the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
33	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
34	Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures

Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of thisState, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of

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Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
with in disbursement of said funds.

4	SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
5	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
6	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
7	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
8	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
9	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
10	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
11	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
12	
13	SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
14	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
15	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
16	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2011 is essential to the operation of
17	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
18	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
19	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2011 could work irreparable harm
20	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
21	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
22	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
23	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2011.
