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7	SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
8	authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
9	and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
10	the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
11	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
12	Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures
13	Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this
14	State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
15	Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied

18	SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
19	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
20	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
21	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
22	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
23	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
24	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
25	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

27	SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
28	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the

Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2011 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2011 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
