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24 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 25 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FOOD 26 SERVICE. If Henderson State University cancels the current contract for food 27 service and chooses to operate the food service with University employees, 28 the President, upon authorization of the Board of Trustees, is allowed to 29 utilize the contingent positions contained in Section 1 of this Act, provided 30 he or she has obtained approval from the Department of Higher Education and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, who has sought prior review by the 31 32 Arkansas Legislative Council.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
2010 2011 through June 30, 2011 2012.

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36 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL 2 ALLOWANCE. The Board of Trustees of Henderson State University may make 3 special allowances available to any coach who coaches more than one sport in 4 an amount not to exceed \$10,000 per fiscal year for any one coach. Further, 5 if the special allowance funds authorized herein are utilized, Henderson 6 State University shall report annually to the Legislative Joint Auditing 7 Committee the exact disposition of those special allowance funds.

8 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
9 <u>2010</u> <u>2011</u> through June 30, <u>2011</u> <u>2012</u>.

11 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 12 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 13 14 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 15 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures 16 17 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this 18 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of 19 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied 20 with in disbursement of said funds.

21

22 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 23 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 24 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 25 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 26 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 27 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 28 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 29 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 30

31 <u>SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General</u> 32 <u>Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the</u> 33 <u>appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the</u> 34 <u>effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2011 is essential to the operation of</u> 35 <u>the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in</u> 36 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
