26	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 5-27-604 is amended to read as follows:
27	5-27-604. Failure to report computer child pornography.
28	(a) A person commits failure to report computer child pornography if
29	the person:
30	(1) Is the owner, operator, or employee of a computer online
31	service, internet service, or bulletin board service; and
32	(2) Knowingly fails to notify a law enforcement official that a
33	subscriber is using the computer online service, internet service, or
34	bulletin board service to commit a violation of § 5-27-603.
35	(a)(1) A person commits failure to report computer child pornography
36	if the person is the owner, operator, or employee of a computer online

14	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 16, Chapter 120, Subchapter 1 is
15	amended to add a new section to read as follows:
16	16-120-106. Immunity for certain persons reporting the existence of
17	child pornography.
18	A person notifying a law enforcement agency of the existence of child
19	pornography under § 5-27-604 is immune from civil liability or damages with
20	respect to making the notification to the law enforcement agency.
