- 25 license application, is amended to read as follows:
- 26 (b) Every application shall:
- 27 (1) State the full name, date of birth, sex, and residence
- 28 address of the applicant;
- 29 (2) Briefly describe the applicant; and
- 30 (3) State whether the applicant has theretofore previously been
- 31 licensed as a driver and, if so, when and by what state or country, whether
- 32 any such license has ever been suspended or revoked, or whether an
- 33 application has ever been refused, and, if so, the date of and reason for
- 34 suspension, revocation, or refusal; and
- 35 (4) State whether the driver has ever been administratively
- 36 barred from taking a driver's license or instruction permit examination.
