1 (iii)(3) Adopt such rules and regulations as are 2 necessary to prevent fraud and, to preserve order in the market, and to ensure the health and safety of the citizens. 3 4 (D) They (d) The governing body may authorize the 5 immediate seizure, arrest, or removal from any market of any person violating 6 its regulations, as established by ordinance, together with any article in 7 that person's possession, and the immediate seizure and destruction of 8 tainted or unsound meat, seafood, poultry, vegetable, fruit, or other 9 provisions. 10 (2) No charge or assessment of any kind shall be made or levied 11 in any manner against any farmer or producer of vegetables or provisions in 12 bringing them to any market in any city, for standing in or occupying a 13 place, with or without horses and wagon used in bringing the produce to the 14 market, in any of the market spaces of the city, or in the streets contiguous 15 thereto, on market days and evenings previous thereto. 16 (b) Nothing contained in this section shall be so construed as to 17 authorize the city council of any city to pass an ordinance for the purpose 18 of assessing or imposing any fine or punishment whatever upon any farmer or 19 producer for selling at any time, within the city, any article of provision 20 or vegetables to any person in any street or streets or market spaces during market hours. 21 22 23 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 14-140-102 is repealed. 24 14-140-102. Hindering or taxing sale of farm products unlawful. 25 (a) It shall be unlawful for any city council, member of an 26 incorporation, corporation, city officer, or any other person, either in an 27 incorporated city or elsewhere, to hinder, or to interfere, or to impose a 28 tax or a license, or to obstruct in any manner whatsoever any person in the selling or the offering for sale of any fruits, vegetables, or any products 29 30 of the farm, including meats from domestic animals or livestock. (b) The benefits of this section shall accrue only to those who 31 32 produce the articles mentioned in subsection (a) of this section or who 33 produce and offer them for sale, either in person or through a legally 34 authorized agent.
