27	<u>(2) "Finan</u>	cial benefit" means any cost for prenatal, delivery,	
28	<u>or postnatal care, incl</u>	iding without limitation reasonable costs for:	
29	<u>(A)</u>	Housing;	
30	<u>(B)</u>	Food;	
31	<u>(C)</u>	Clothing;	
32	<u>(D)</u>	Medical expenses; or	
33	<u>(E)</u>	General maintenance; and	
34	(3) "Prospective adoptive parent" means a person who through his		
35	or her actions has a stated or unstated intention to begin the process of		
36	adopting a minor, whether or not the minor is known to him or her.

1	(b) A person commits the offense of defrauding a prospective adoptive		
2	parent if he or she:		
3	(1) Knowingly obtains a financial benefit from a prospective		
4	adoptive parent or from an agent of a prospective adoptive parent with a		
5	purpose to defraud the prospective adoptive parent or the agent of the		
6	prospective adoptive parent of the financial benefit; and		
7	(2) Does not:		
8	(A) Consent to the adoption; or		
9	(B) Complete the adoption process.		
10	(c) Defrauding an adoptive parent is a:		
11	(1) Class B felony if:		
12	(A) The aggregate financial benefit is two thousand five		
13	hundred dollars (\$2500) or more; or		
14	(B) The person has previously been convicted under this

16	(2) Class C felony if the aggregate financial benefit is:		
17	(A) Five hundred dollars (\$500) or more but less than two		
18	thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500); or
