19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-106-111(a)(1), concerning exemptions
22 under the Consumer-Patient Radiation Health and Safety Act, is amended to
23 read as follows:

24 (a)(1) Dentists, dental hygienists, registered dental assistants with
25 the expanded duty of radiography, radiation health physicists, radiation
26 *medical physicists, chiropractic externs, chiropractic aides or chiropractic*
27 *assistants, or both with the expanded duty of radiography, bone*
28 *densitometrists, and certified medical dosimetrists are excluded from this*
29 *chapter.*
30

31 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 17-106-111(a), concerning exemptions under
32 the Consumer-Patient Radiation Health and Safety Act, is amended to add two
33 additional subdivisions to read as follows:

34 *(3) The Arkansas State Board of Chiropractic Examiners shall*
35 *adopt rules in accordance with standards recommended by the American Registry*
36 *of Radiological Technologists for education, testing, and certification of*



1 chiropractic aides or assistants.

2 (4) This subsection does not prohibit chiropractic aides or
3 chiropractic assistants, or both from obtaining radiological certification
4 through the Department of Health.
