BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-106-111(a)(1), concerning exemptions under the Consumer-Patient Radiation Health and Safety Act, is amended to read as follows:
(a)(1) Dentists, dental hygienists, registered dental assistants with the expanded duty of radiography, radiation health physicists, radiation medical physicists, chiropractic externs, chiropractic aides or chiropractic assistants, or both with the expanded duty of radiography, bone densitometrists, and certified medical dosimetrists are excluded from this chapter.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 17-106-111(a), concerning exemptions under the Consumer-Patient Radiation Health and Safety Act, is amended to add two additional subdivisions to read as follows:
(3) The Arkansas State Board of Chiropractic Examiners shall adopt rules in accordance with standards recommended by the American Registry of Radiological Technologists for education, testing, and certification of
chiropractic aides or assistants.
(4) This subsection does not prohibit chiropractic aides or chiropractic assistants, or both from obtaining radiological certification through the Department of Health.
