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19	SECTION 1. Arka	nsas Code § 23-78-107(a), concerning offices and	
20	employees of the Buria	Association Board, is amended to read as follows:

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35	SECTION 2. Arka	nsas Code § 23-78-110 is amended to read as follows:	
36	23-78-110. Certi	ficate of authority.	

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- 1 (a) Applications for certificate of authority shall be on forms 2 furnished by the Burial Association Board, and no burial association shall 3 begin operation until the application shall have been approved and 4 certificate of authority shall have been granted by the board.
  - (b) The following documents and information shall be filed with the application for a certificate of authority:
- 7 (1) Consent to service of process upon the secretary of the 8 applicant;
- 9 (2) Gopy A copy of the proposed form of membership application,
  10 membership certificate, bylaws, and contracts for service, merchandise,
  11 supplies, and any other data requested by the board; and
- 12 (3) References as to character, ability, and integrity of the 13 organizers and of any funeral director or embalmer with whom the applicant 14 proposes to contract;
- 15 (4) An application fee as determined by rule of the board; and
  16 (5)(A) Proof of a deposit to the association's mortuary funds in
  17 an amount determined by rule of the board.
  - (B) The deposit required under subdivision (b)(5)(A) of this section shall not exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000).
  - (c) If the board is satisfied that the applicant is qualified and meets the requirements of this chapter, it the board shall issue to the applicant a certificate of authority upon receipt of the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500).

SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 23-78-111(a)(2), concerning burial association license fees, is amended to read as follows:

(2) The board shall collect the annual license fee from each burial association that is operating and in good standing on January 1 or before February 15 of the year in which the license fee is payable.

SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 23-78-120(a) and (b), concerning semiannual reports to the Burial Association Board, are amended to read as follows:

(a)(1) Each Using forms provided by the Burial Association Board, each burial association or society licensed in this state shall file a semiannual report showing the actual financial condition of the <u>burial</u> association or society as of June 30 and December 31 of each year on forms provided by the

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1	Burial Association Board.		
2	(2) The report shall include documents and information as		
3	required by rule of the board.		
4	(b) $(1)(A)$ The report required under this section is due as of June 30		
5	and December 31 of each year and shall be filed within thirty (30) days from		
6	the date upon which it is due.		
7	(B) A report is delinquent if:		
8	(i) It is due as of June 30, and it is filed with		
9	the board after August 15 of the year it is due; or		
10	(ii) It is due as of December 31, and it is filed		
11	with the board after February 15 of the year next following the year it is		
12	due.		
13	(2) If a due date under subdivision (b)(1) of this section falls		
14	on a weekend or holiday, the report shall be due on the first business day		
15	following the weekend or holiday.		
16	(3) (A) The board may grant an extension of time to submit a		
17	report for good cause.		
18	(B) A burial association or society shall file a request		
19	for an extension to the board in writing before the due date of the report.		
20	(4)(A) A report submitted to the board that omits required		
21	documents or information shall not be considered as filed with the board and		
22	will be returned to the burial association or society for corrections or		
23	<pre>completion.</pre>		
24	(B) A report that omits required documents or information		
25	is delinquent if the submission of documents or information to complete the		
26	report:		
27	(i) Causes a report that is due as of June 30 to be		
28	filed with the board after August 15 of the year it is due; or		
29	(ii) Causes a report that is due as of December 31		
30	to be filed with the board after February 15 of the year next following the		
31	year it is due.		
32	(5) A burial association or society whose report is delinquent		
33	is subject to a financial penalty established by rule of the board.		
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35	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code $\S$ 23-78-125 is amended to read as follows:		
36	23-78-125. Revocation of certificate, license, charter, etc Appeal.		

1	(a) Upon the revocation of any certificate of authority, charter, or		
2	other authority by the Burial Association Board under any of the provisions		
3	of this chapter, the association or person whose certificate of authority,		
4	charter, license, or other authority has been revoked shall have the right of		
5	appeal from the action of the board revoking the certificate of authority,		
6	charter, or other authority to the circuit court of the county in which the		
7	burial association may be located.		
8	(b) Appeals shall be made in accordance with the Arkansas		
9	Administrative Procedure Act, § 25-15-201 et seq.		
10	(c) Upon receipt of a notice of appeal, the board shall file with the		
11	clerk of the circuit court the decision of the board. The clerk of the		
12	circuit court shall then transfer the appeal to the civil docket as in cases		
13	of appeal from a justice of the peace.		
14	(d) The appeal shall be heard de novo by the court without a jury.		
15	(e) Either party shall have the right of appeal to the Arkansas		
16	Supreme Court.		
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
