2	auction in the State of Arkansas shall be open only to persons who possess an
3	Arkansas salvage auction buyer's identification card issued under this
4	section.
5	(b)(l)(A) The salvage auction buyer's identification card authorizing
6	persons to bid or buy motor vehicles at a salvage auction shall be available
7	to any person, business, or corporation, or an employee thereof, that:
8	(i) Possesses a valid new motor vehicle dealer
9	license under § 23-112-301, a used motor vehicle dealer license under § 23-
10	112-607, a valid wrecker license under § 27-14-2001, or is a licensed motor
11	vehicle dealer from another state under § 23-112-616; and
