33	33 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - GRANTS TO FIRE	DEPARTMENTS. There is hereby	
34	34 appropriated, to the Department of Finance and A	dministration - Disbursing	
35	Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor		
36	36 fund or fund accounts, the following:		



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1	(A) for grants to fire departments, in a sum not to exceed	
2	\$5,000,000.

4	SECTION 2. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS	
5	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FIRE	
6	DEPARTMENT GRANT ALLOCATION AND UTILIZATION. The Department of Finance and	
7	Administration shall distribute the fire department grants appropriation and	
8	funds authorized by this act, or so much thereof as is available, to each	
9	county based on the percentages as prescribed in Arkansas Code 14-284-403.	
10	The fire department grants authorized by this act may be used by the fire	
11	departments for maintenance and general operations, fire fighting training	
12	expenses, purchase of firefighting equipment and other expenses necessary to	
13	provide fire fighting protection.	
14	No less than thirty (30) days prior to the distribution of any funds	
15	appropriated by this act, the director of the agency shall notify the Speaker	
16	of the House of Representatives of the name and address of each recipient and	
17	the amount that is being distributed to each recipient.	
18	The Fire Departments receiving grants authorized by this act are not	
19	subject to meeting the requirements or other criteria that may be required of	
20	fire departments under the provisions of Act 833 of 1991, as amended, or	
21	<u>Arkansas Code 14-284-401 through 14-284-411.</u>	
22		
23	SECTION 3. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor	
24	obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects	
25	described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available	
26	therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and	
27	agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and	
28	donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or	
29	funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State	
30	Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects	
31	enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds	
32	otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General	
33	Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall	
34	not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.	
35	(B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State	

Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the

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Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of
this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided
otherwise by law.

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7 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 8 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 9 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 10 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 11 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 12 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 13 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 14 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 15

16 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 17 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 18 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 19 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2011 is essential to the operation of 20 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the 21 22 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2011 could work irreparable harm 23 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 24 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 25 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health 26 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2011. 27 28 29 30 31 32

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
