17	AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR GRANTS TO
18	FIRE DEPARTMENTS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE
19	AND ADMINISTRATION - DISBURSING OFFICER FOR
20	GENERAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS; AND FOR OTHER
21	PURPOSES.

25	AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND
26	ADMINISTRATION - DISBURSING OFFICER -
27	GRANTS TO FIRE DEPARTMENTS GENERAL
28	IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATION.
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31	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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33	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - GRANTS TO FIRE DEPARTMENTS. There is hereby
34	appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing
35	Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor
36	fund or fund accounts, the following:



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1	(A) for grants to fire departments, in a sum not to exceed
2	\$5,000,000.
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4	SECTION 2. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
5	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FIRE
6	DEPARTMENT GRANT ALLOCATION AND UTILIZATION. The Department of Finance and
7	Administration shall distribute the fire department grants appropriation and
8	funds authorized by this act, or so much thereof as is available, to each
9	county based on the percentages as prescribed in Arkansas Code 14-284-403.
10	The fire department grants authorized by this act may be used by the fire
11	departments for maintenance and general operations, fire fighting training
12	expenses, purchase of firefighting equipment and other expenses necessary to
13	provide fire fighting protection. Notwithstanding any other provision of law
14	to the contrary regarding the distribution of funds, any funds distributed to
15	Pulaski County Fire Departments as authorized in Section 1 of this Act shall
16	be distributed solely based on a per capita basis.
17	No less than thirty (30) days prior to the distribution of any funds
18	appropriated by this act, the director of the agency shall notify the Speaker
19	of the House of Representatives of the name and address of each recipient and
20	the amount that is being distributed to each recipient.
21	The Fire Departments receiving grants authorized by this act are not
22	subject to meeting the requirements or other criteria that may be required of
23	fire departments under the provisions of Act 833 of 1991, as amended, or
24	<u>Arkansas Code 14-284-401 through 14-284-411.</u>
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26	SECTION 3. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor

27 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects 28 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available 29 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and 30 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and 31 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or 32 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State 33 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects 34 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds 35 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General 36 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall

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not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

2 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State 3 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the 4 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of 5 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and 6 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in 7 disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided 8 otherwise by law.

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10 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 11 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 12 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 13 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 14 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 15 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 16 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 17 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 18

19 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 20 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 21 22 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2011 is essential to the operation of 23 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 24 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2011 could work irreparable harm 25 26 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 27 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health 28 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2011. 29 30 /s/Webb 31 32 33

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
