29	his or her person, in a vehicle occupied by him or her, or otherwise readily
30	available for use with a purpose to employ the handgun, knife, or club as a
31	weapon against a person+;
32	(2) Carries a handgun, knife, or club into an establishment that
33	sells alcoholic beverages; or
34	(3) Possesses a handgun on or about his or her person or
35	otherwise readily available for use as a weapon against a person while under
36	the influence of alcohol or while under the influence or in the possession of

a controlled substance.

- 2 (b) As used in this section:
- 3 (1) "Club" means any instrument that is specially designed,
- 4 made, or adapted for the purpose of inflicting serious physical injury or
- 5 death by striking, including a blackjack, billie, and sap;
