## Subtitle

TO CLARIFY THE PROCEDURES FOR OBTAINING BOOKS AND ACCOUNTING RECORDS UNDER THE ARKANSAS NONPROFIT CORPORATION ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 4-28-218 is amended to read as follows: 4-28-218. Books and accounting records.
(a) Each corporation shall keep correct and complete books and records of account.
(b) All The receipts of moneys and expenditures shall be properly recorded according to accepted accounting principles.
(c) A record of the proceedings of its members, board of directors, and committees shall be kept.
(d) A record of the names and addresses of its members entitled to vote shall be maintained at the principal office or place of business of the corporation.
(e) All The books and records of a corporation may be inspected by any a member for any a proper purpose at any reasonable time.
(f)(1) By making a verbal or written request, a member of a corporation may obtain a monthly or other periodic financial report identical to the monthly or periodic financial report provided to members of the 7
governing board of the corporation.
