23	SECTION 1.	Arkansas Code § 6-17-413(d)(1) and (2), concerning the
24	Department of Educ	ation's payment of a bonus to licensed speech-language
25	pathologists in pu	blic schools, are amended to read as follows:
26	(d)(l) As u	sed in this subsection, " certified speech-language
27	pathologist" means	a speech-language pathologist who:

1 incentive bonus of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) to a speech-language 2 pathologist who: 3 (A) Holds an Arkansas teaching license in speech-language 4 pathology; 5 (B) Is a full-time employee of an Arkansas education 6 service cooperative or public school district as a speech-language 7 pathologist at the time of receiving the bonus; and 8 (C) Is not considered a purchased service contractor but 9 may be employed under a teacher contract subject to renewal under § 6-17-10 1506. 11 12 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-17-413(d) concerning bonuses paid to 13 licensed speech-language pathologists, is amended to add an additional 14 subdivision to read as follows: 15 (5)(A)(i) If a speech-language pathologist who receives a bonus 16 under this subsection leaves employment in the Arkansas public school system 17 before completing three (3) continuous school years of employment, the 18 speech-language pathologist shall repay the department a prorated portion of 19 the bonus received in the school year based on a daily rate for the remainder 20 of a school year in which the speech-language pathologist leaves employment. (ii) The first year of the three (3) continuous 21 22 school years is the first year that the speech-language pathologist received 23 a bonus under this subsection (d). 24 (iii) The daily rate is calculated as the amount of 25 the annual bonus paid to the speech-language pathologist divided by the 26 number of days in the speech-language pathologist's contract. 27 (B) The State Board of Education may suspend the Arkansas speech-language pathology license of any person who fails to repay the amount 28 of the bonus required to be repaid under this subdivision (d)(5). 29 30 (C) Repayment of all or a portion of a bonus under this subdivision (d)(5) is not required if, due to the death or disability of the 31 32 speech-language pathologist or other extenuating circumstances as may be 33 recognized by the State Board of Education, the speech-language pathologist 34 does not remain employed in the Arkansas public school system for three (3) continuous school years after first receiving the bonus under this 35 36 subsection.
