## For An Act To Be Entitled

an act to give priority for an arkansas academic Challenge scholarship to a student whose parent was $A$ MEMBER OF THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES AND WAS KILLED WHILE PERFORMING MILITARY DUTY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-85-212(e), concerning scholarship awards under the Arkansas Academic Challenge Scholarship Program - Part 2, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:
(5) The department shall give priority for a scholarship award to a full-time or part-time student:
(A) Who meets the eligibility requirements under this
subchapter; and
(B) Whose parent, by birth or legal adoption:
(i) Was a resident of the State of Arkansas at the time that person entered the service of the United States armed forces or whose official residence is in Arkansas; and
(ii) Was a member of the United States Armed Forces
who was killed while performing military duty:
(a) In a status identified under 32 U.S.C. § 101 et seq. or 10 U.S.C. $\mathcal{S} 101$ et seq. as they existed on January 1, 2011; or (b) In state active duty status.
