## For An Act To Be Entitled

an act to amend the penalties for no proof of LIABILITY INSURANCE ON A PERSON'S MOTOR VEHICLE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

 TO AMEND THE PENALTIES FOR NO PROOF OF LIABILITY INSURANCE ON A PERSON'S MOTOR vehicle.BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-65-117(a)(1)(A), regarding the seizure and sale of motor vehicles, is amended to read as follows:
(a)(1)(A) Any person who pleads guilty or nolo contendere, of is found guilty of violating § 5-65-103 for a fourth offense occurring within three (3) years of the first offense, or has his or her vehicle impounded under § 27-22-103, at the discretion of the court, may have his or her motor vehicle seized.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 27-22-103 is amended to read as follows:
27-22-103. Penalty.
(a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, any person who operates a motor vehicle within this state upon conviction shall be subject to a mandatory fine of not less than fifty dollars ( $\$ 50.00$ ) nor more than two hundred fifty dollars ( $\$ 250$ ) unless both the vehicle and the person's operation of the vehicle are covered by a certificate of selfinsurance or an insurance policy as required under § 27-22-104(a)(1).
(b)(1) Any person who operates a motor vehicle in violation of § 27-22-104(a)(1) shall be fined not less than two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500) for the second offense, and upon conviction the minimum fine shall be mandatory.
(2) (A) Any person who operates a motor vehicle in violation of § 27-22-104(a)(1) shall be fined not less than five hundred dollars (\$500) nor more than one thousand dollars ( $\$ 1,000$ ) or sentenced to one ( 1 ) year in jail, or both, for the third offense or for any subsequent offenses upon conviction is guilty of a Class A misdemeanor.
(B) A person who has been convicted under subdivision
(b) (2) of this section shall:
(i) Be punished by imprisonment of not less than two (2) days in jail; and
(ii) Have his or her motor vehicle impounded by a law enforcement agency and shall be punished by imprisonment for not less than two (2) days nor more than six (6) months if he or she is found during a traffic stop to have no valid policy of liability insurance as required by § 27-22-104.
(a) The person shall be able to retrieve the impounded motor vehicle:
(1) Upon the showing of a valid policy of liability insurance as required by § 27-22-104; and
(2) After paying any tow expense
incurred as a result of the impounding of the motor vehicle under this section.
(b) If the motor vehicle has not been
retrieved by the owner within one hundred twenty (120) days of the motor vehicle being impounded, the motor vehicle may be seized and sold under the provisions of § 5-65-117.
(3) Upon a showing that liability coverage required by §§ 27-22-101-27-22-104 was in effect at the time of arrest, the judge may dismiss the charge imposed under this act, and the penalties therefore shall not be imposed.
(c) If the arresting officer is:
(1) An officer of the Department of Arkansas State Police, the fine collected shall be remitted by the tenth day of each month to the

Administration of Justice Fund Section of the Office of Administrative Services of the Department of Finance and Administration, on a form provided by that office, for deposit in the Department of Arkansas State Police Fund to be used for the purchase and maintenance of state police vehicles;
(2) A county law enforcement officer, the fine collected shall be deposited in that county fund used for the purchase and maintenance of rescue, emergency medical, and law enforcement vehicles, communications equipment, animals owned or used by law enforcement agencies, life-saving medical apparatus, and law enforcement apparatus to be used for those purposes; or
(3) A municipal law enforcement officer, the fine collected shall be deposited in that municipal fund used for the purchase and maintenance of rescue, emergency medical, and law enforcement vehicles, communications equipment, animals owned or used by law enforcement agencies, life-saving medical apparatus, and law enforcement apparatus to be used for those purposes.
