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36	20-8-602. Alzheim	er's Advisory Council — Creati	<u>ion — Membership.</u>

1	(a) There is created the Alzheimer's Advisory Council to consist of
2	seventeen (17) members as follows:
3	(1) Four (4) members appointed by the Speaker of the House of
4	Representatives as follows:
5	(A) One (1) member of the House of Representatives;
6	(B) One (1) member who has been diagnosed with Alzheimer's
7	disease;
8	(C) One (1) member to represent the health care provider
9	community; and
10	(D) One (1) member to represent the adult day services
11	industry;
12	(2) Four (4) members appointed by the President Pro Tempore of
13	the Senate as follows:
14	(A) One (1) member of the Senate;
15	(B) One (1) member who is a paid caregiver of a person
16	with Alzheimer's disease;
17	(C) One (1) member to represent the assisted living
18	industry; and
19	(D) One (1) member who is a scientist who specializes in
20	Alzheimer's research;
21	(3) Four (4) members appointed by the Governor as follows:
22	(A) One (1) member who is a family member of a person
23	living with Alzheimer's disease or other form of dementia;
24	(B) One (1) member to represent the nursing facility
25	<pre>industry;</pre>
26	(C) One (1) member who is a person active in the state
27	chapter of the Alzheimer's Association; and
28	(D) One (1) member who is a person active in the state
29	chapter of Alzheimer's Arkansas Programs and Services; and
30	(4) Five (5) members as follows:
31	(A) The Director of the Department of Health or his or her
32	designee;
33	(B) The Director of the Department of Human Services or
34	his or her designee;

5	(b) Members of the council shall be appointed by September 1, 2011.	
6	(c)(l) Members of the council shall serve at the pleasure of their	
7	appointing authorities.	
8	(2) A vacancy on the council shall be filled by the original	
9	appointing authority.	
10	(d)(1) The Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President	
11	Pro Tempore of the Senate shall each designate a cochair from among the	
12	members of the council.	
13	(2) The cochairs shall jointly call the first meeting of the	
14	council.	
15	(e)(1) A majority of the members of the council shall constitute a	
16	quorum.	
17	(2) A majority vote of the members present is required for any	
18	action of the council.	
19	(f) Task force meetings shall be held in Pulaski County, Arkansas, and	
20	at other locations in the state as the council shall deem necessary.	
21	(g) The Bureau of Legislative Research shall provide staff support to	
22	the council as necessary to assist the council in the performance of its	
23	<u>duties.</u>	
24	(h) Legislative members of the council shall be reimbursed for	
25	expenses and per diem at the same rate and from the same source as provided	
26	by law for members of the General Assembly attending meetings of the interim	
27	committees.	
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29	<u>20-8-603. Duties.</u>	
30	(a) The Alzheimer's Advisory Council shall:	
31	(1) Assess the current and future impact of Alzheimer's disease	
32	and other types of dementia on the residents of the State of Arkansas;	
33	(2) Examine the existing industries, services, and resources	
34	addressing the needs of persons living with Alzheimer's disease, their	
35	families, and caregivers; and	
36	(3) Develop a strategy to mobilize a state response to the	

1	public health crisis created by Alzheimer's disease and other types of		
2	dementia.		
3	(b) The council shall include the following in its assessments and		
4	recommendations:		
5	(1) Statewide trends in the number of persons living with		
6	Alzheimer's disease and other forms of dementia and the needs of those		
7	persons;		
8	(2) The state's role in providing long-term care, family		
9	caregiver support, and other forms of assistance to persons with early-stage		
10	and younger onset of Alzheimer's disease;		
11	(3) State policy regarding persons with Alzheimer's disease and		
12	developmental disabilities;		
13	(4) Existing services, resources, and capacity, including		
14	without limitation:		
15	(A) The type, cost, and availability of dementia services;		
16	(B) The dementia-specific training requirements for long-		
17	term care staff;		
18	(C) Quality care measures for residential care facilities;		
19	(D) The capacity of public safety and law enforcement		
20	agencies to respond to persons with Alzheimer's disease;		
21	(E) The availability of home-based and community-based		
22	resources for persons with Alzheimer's disease, including the availability of		
23	respite care for families;		
24	(F) An inventory of long-term care dementia care units;		
25	(G) The adequacy and appropriateness of geriatric		
26	psychiatric units for persons with behavioral disorders associated with		
27	Alzheimer's and related dementia;		
28	(H) The assisted living residential options for persons		
29	with dementia; and		
30	(I) State support for Alzheimer's research; and		
31	(5) Needed state policies or responses, including without		
32	<pre>limitation:</pre>		
33	(A) Directions for the provision of clear and coordinated		
34	services and supports for persons and families living with Alzheimer's and		
35	related disorders; and		
36	(R) Strategies for addressing identified gaps in services

4	and recommendations for meeting the Alzheimer's disease needs in the State of		
5	Arkansas to the House Committee on Public Health, Welfare, and Labor and the		
6	Senate Committee on Public Health, Welfare, and Labor on or before October 1		
7	of each year.		
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
