## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO REQUIRE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION TO MAKE A GOOD FAITH EFFORT TO OBTAIN THE STUDENT CONSENT FORM AND COLLECT AND REPORT THE DATA REQUIRED UNDER THE ARKANSAS SCHOLARSHIP LOTTERY ACT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-85-215(d), concerning the obligation of an approved institution of higher education to collect the student consent form required under the Arkansas Scholarship Lottery Act, is amended to read as follows:
(d)(1) Approved institutions of higher education shall undertake any procedures necessary to ensure the collection of the information under this section and shall provide it to the bureau in a mutually agreed upon electronic format by November 1 of each school year for students awarded for that academic year state-supported student financial assistance.
(2) An approved institution of higher education may lose its approved status for receiving scholarship funds on behalf of a recipient
under this subchapter if it fails to make a good faith effort to:
(A) Collect the student form required under this section;
or
(B) Comply with subdivision (d)(1) of this section.
