3	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 15-11-705(a), concerning the development of		
4	wildlife observation trails, is amended to read as follows:		
5	(a) To accept a wildlife observation trail into the Wildlife		
6	Observation Trails Pilot Program and be eligible to receive grant moneys		
7	under this subchapter, the Department of Parks and Tourism shall require that		
8	the trail:		
9	(1) $\frac{\text{Meet}}{\text{Meet}}$ the criteria established by the department after		
10	consultation with the Wildlife Observation Trails Pilot Program Advisory		
11	Board. The criteria includes without limitation:		
12	(A) A right-of-way or easement for public use for a		
13	minimum period of ten (10) years;		
14	(B) Trail operation and maintenance by a responsible		
15	organization for a minimum period of ten (10) years;		
16	(C) Adherence to state trails standards and guidelines for		
17	the trail type designated;		
18	(D) Location and design of the trail so that it is		
19	optimally attractive for wildlife observation;		
20	(E) Readiness of the trail for public use; and		
21	(F) Proper marking and signing;		
22	(2) conform Conform to goals established in the Statewide		
23	Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan or the Arkansas Trails Plan; and		
24	(3) promote Promote tourism and economic development.

26	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 15-11-706 is amended to read as follows:		
27	15-11-706. Wildlife Observation Trails Pilot Program Advisory Board $-$		
28	Created.		
29	(a)(1) There is created an advisory body to the Department of Parks		
30	and Tourism to be known as the "Wildlife Observation Trails Pilot Program		
31	Advisory Board" to provide recommendations to the Director of the Department		
32	of Parks and Tourism and the Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission to		
33	develop criteria to establish and fund the development and maintenance of		
34	wildlife observation trails through the distribution of grant moneys under		
35	this subchapter.		

(2) The board is a voluntary board that consists of seven (7)

- 1 members that are appointed by the Director of the Department of Parks and
- 2 Tourism as follows:
- 3 (A) One (1) representative of the Arkansas Economic
- 4 Development Commission;
- 5 (B) One (1) representative of the Arkansas State Game and
- 6 Fish Commission;
- 7 (C) One (1) representative of the Arkansas Recreation and
- 8 Parks Association;
- 9 (D) One (1) representative of the Association of Arkansas
- 10 Counties;
- 11 (E) One (1) representative of the Arkansas Game and Fish
- 12 Foundation;
- 13 (F) One (1) representative of the Arkansas Audubon
- 14 Society; and
- 15 (G) One (1) representative of the Arkansas Municipal
- 16 League.
- 17 (b)(1) The Director of the Department of Parks and Tourism shall:
- 18 <u>(1)</u> assist Assist the board in establishing criteria consistent
- 19 with § 15-11-705 by the promulgation of rules in accordance with the Arkansas
- 20 Administrative Procedure Act, § 25-15-201 et seq., for recommendation of a
- 21 grant for the development of a wildlife observation trail in the Wildlife
- 22 Observation Trails Pilot Program.; and
- 23 (2) The Director of the Department of Parks and Tourism shall
- 24 seek Seek recommendations from the board for the selection of a grant
- 25 recipient.

- 24 (a)(1) A grant application under this subchapter that meets the
- 25 criteria under § 15-11-705 shall be submitted to the Wildlife Observation
- 26 Trails Pilot Program Advisory Board by the Director of the Department of
- 27 Parks and Tourism for review and comment.
- 28 (2) The advisory board shall recommend grants for approval by
- 29 the director.
- 30 (3) The director shall designate the grant recipients that are
- 31 eligible for moneys under this subchapter and notify the Arkansas State Game
- 32 and Fish Commission of the grant recipients.
- 33 (b) The commission agrees to receive grant designations submitted by
- 34 the director and approve distribution of moneys annually to eligible grant
- 35 recipients in the Wildlife Observation Trails Pilot Program as follows:
- 36 (1) A maximum of eighty percent (80%) of the moneys for grants

- 1 for wildlife observation trail development to cities or counties; and
- 2 (2) A maximum of twenty percent (20%) of the moneys for grants
- 3 for wildlife observation trail development to state agencies or nonprofit
- 4 organizations.

- 17 15-47-101. Title.
- 18 This subchapter shall be known and may be cited as the "Wildlife
- 19 Recreation Facilities Pilot Program".

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- 21 SECTION 9. Arkansas Code § 15-47-102(5) and (6), concerning findings,
- 22 is amended to read as follows:
- 23 (5) The Department of Rural Services and the commission are
- 24 interested in developing a Wildlife Recreation Facilities Pilot Program to
- 25 ignite interest in the wildlife resources of Arkansas and to promote economic
- 26 development in the state through the use and enjoyment of the state's
- 27 abundant wildlife resources; and
- 28 (6) To further carry out the mission of the commission, a
- 29 Wildlife Recreation Facilities Pilot Program should be implemented to
- 30 establish criteria and construct wildlife recreation facilities, including
- 31 without limitation the development of community ponds, shooting ranges,
- 32 community fishing, and access areas for fishing.

- 34 SECTION 10. Arkansas Code § 15-47-103 is amended to read as follows:
- 35 15-47-103. Wildlife Recreation Facilities Pilot Program.
- 36 (a) There is created a program to be known as the "Wildlife Recreation

- 1 Facilities Pilot Program".
- 2 (b) The program shall be developed, implemented, and administered by
- 3 the Department of Rural Services and the Arkansas Rural Development
- 4 Commission with the assistance of the Arkansas State Game and Fish
- 5 Commission.
- 6 (c) The purpose of the program is to:
- 7 (1) Create better access to outdoor wildlife recreational 8 activities for Arkansans;
- 9 (2) Attract tourists for the enjoyment and utilization of wildlife sports, including hunting and fishing;
- 11 (3) Ignite interest in the wildlife resources and nature 12 appreciation activities of Arkansas; and
- 13 (4) Promote economic development in the state through the use 14 and enjoyment of the state's abundant wildlife resources.
 - (d) The department and the commission agree to work cooperatively to establish criteria and recommendations for wildlife recreation facilities, including without limitation the development of community ponds, shooting ranges, community fishing, and access areas for fishing for the enjoyment of the wildlife resources of the state by our citizens and visitors to the state who are attracted to Arkansas's abundant wildlife resources.
 - (e) The department and the commission agree to develop plans and review the needs and requirements for the construction and development of wildlife recreation facilities under the program.
- 24 (f) The department, with the assistance and advice of the commission, 25 shall establish criteria for the wildlife recreation facilities by the 26 promulgation of rules in accordance with the Arkansas Administrative 27 Procedure Act, § 25-15-201 et seq., for the development of wildlife 28 recreation facilities in the program.

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- 30 SECTION 11. Arkansas Code § 15-47-104(a), concerning funding, is 31 amended to read as follows:
- 32 (a)(1) The Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission voluntarily agrees 33 to make available one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the fiscal biennium 34 beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011, annually for the Wildlife 35 Recreation Facilities Pilot Program for the development of wildlife 36 recreation facilities under this subchapter from moneys that the commission
