- 5 (2) The advisory board shall recommend grants for approval by 6 the director.
- 7 (3) The director shall designate the grant recipients that are 8 eligible for moneys under this subchapter and notify the Arkansas State Game 9 and Fish Commission of the grant recipients.
- 10 (b) The commission agrees to receive grant designations submitted by
  11 the director and approve distribution of moneys annually to eligible grant
