21	SECTION 1. Arka	ansas Code § 17-25-501 is ameno	ded to read as follows:
22	17-25-501. Purp	pose.	
23	It is the intent	t of this subchapter to protect	t <u>homeowners and</u> the
24	purchasers of homes co	onstructed in this state by esu	tablishing reasonable and
25	adequate licensing and	d regulation of homebuilders <u>, i</u>	remodelers, and home
26	<u>improvement contractor</u>	<u>rs</u> . It is intended that this su	ubchapter apply to
27	everyone not specifica	ally excluded. It is also the i	intent of this subchapter

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1	(1) "Home improvement contractor" means any person, firm,	
2	partnership, co-partnership, association, corporation, or other organization	
3	or any combination that attempts to or submits a bid, or contracts,	
4	undertakes, or assumes charge in a supervisory capacity or otherwise manages	
5	the reconstruction, alteration, renovation, repair, modification,	
6	improvement, removal, demolition, or addition to any preexisting single-	
7	family residence or the property and structures appurtenant thereto;	
8	(2) "Residential building contractor" means any person, firm,	
9	partnership, copartnership, association, corporation, or other organization	
10	or any combination thereof , which for a fixed price, commission, fee, or	
11	wage <u>,</u> attempts to or submits a bid to construct or contract or undertakes to	
12	construct or assumes charge in a supervisory capacity or otherwise manages	
13	the construction of <u>a</u> single family residences <u>single-family residence or the</u>	
14	property and structures appurtenant to the residence; and	
15	(3) " Single family <u>Single-family</u> residence" means any project	
16	consisting of one (1) but not more than four (4) units of new construction	
17	for residential occupancy , when the cost of the project is twenty thousand	
18	dollars (\$20,000) or more. This definition does not apply to subcontractors	
19	of licensed residential building contractors or to remodeling operations.	
20		
21	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 17-25-503(a)(1), concerning the Residential	
22	Contractors Committee, is amended to read as follows:	
23	(a)(l) There is created the <u>"</u> Residential Building Contractors	
24	Committee", to consist of seven (7) members.	
25		
26	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 17-25-504 is amended to read as follows:	
27	17-25-504. Authority.	
28	The Residential Building Contractors Committee may:	
29	(1) Issue, modify, suspend, and revoke residential building	
30	contractor's licenses <u>issued by the committee</u> ;	
31	(2) Establish qualifications for residential building	
32	contractor's licenses <u>issued by the committee</u> ;	
33	(3) Enforce this subchapter and the committee's regulations	
34	<u>rules</u> ;	
35	(4) Issue regulations <u>rules</u> necessary for the implementation of	

1	(5) Levy civil penalties in the same amounts and under the same
2	procedures as prescribed for the Contractors Licensing Board under this
3	subchapter;
4	(6) Issue orders of abatement in the same manner and to the same
5	extent as authorized for the board <u>Contractors Licensing Board under § 17-25-</u>
6	<u>103;</u> and
7	(7) Seek any other civil remedies which are available to the
8	board.

10	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 17-25-505 is amended to read as follows:
11	17-25-505. License from committee required.
12	<u>(a)</u> No <u>A</u> person shall <u>not</u> act as a residential building contractor
13	after July 1, 2001, unless licensed by the Residential Building Contractors
14	Committee or exempted from licensure under this subchapter.
15	(b) A person shall not act as a home improvement contractor after July
16	<u>1, 2013, unless:</u>
17	(1) Licensed by the Residential Contractors Committee; or
18	(2) Exempt from licensure under this subchapter.
19	
20	SECTION 6. Arkansas Code § 17-25-506(a), concerning applications for
21	licenses from the Residential Building Contractors Committee, is amended to
22	read as follows:
23	17-25-506. Application for license.
24	(a) Applications for licensure shall be made on forms prescribed by
25	the Residential Building Contractors Committee and shall have attached
26	thereto:
27	(1) A compiled financial statement with each new application;
28	and
29	(2) Such other information as required by the committee.
30	
31	SECTION 7. Arkansas Code § 17-25-507 is amended to read as follows:
32	17-25-507. Applicant qualifications.
33	(a) In determining the qualifications of any applicant for original
34	license or any renewal license, the Residential Building Contractors
35	Committee shall consider, among other things, the following:
36	(1) Experience;

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1	(2) Ability;	
2	(3) The manner of performance of previous contracts;	
3	(4) Financial condition;	
4	(5) Citizenship, legal residency, or legal status to work in the	
5	<u>United States;</u>	
6	(5) (6) Any other fact tending to show ability and willingness to	
7	conserve the public health and safety; and	
8	(6)(7) Default in complying with the provisions of this	
9	subchapter or any other law of the state.	
10	(b)(1) The committee may limit a license issued by the committee to	
11	the character of work for which the applicant is qualified to perform.	
12	(2) The categories to which a license may be limited shall	
13	include without limitation:	
14	(A) A residential building contractor; and	
15	(B) A home improvement contractor.	
16		
17	SECTION 8. Arkansas Code § 17-25-508 is amended to read as follows:	
18	17-25-508. Name of licensed contractor.	
19	Residential building contractors A contractor licensed under this	
20	subchapter may act as such only in the name under which they are licensed by	
21	the Residential Building Contractors Committee.	
22		
23	SECTION 9. Arkansas Code § 17-25-509 is amended to read as follows:	
24	17-25-509. Written examination.	
25	(a) Except as otherwise provided in this section, no <u>a</u> person shall	
26	not be licensed as a residential building contractor unless the person has	
27	passed a written examination prescribed by the Residential Building	
28	Contractors Committee.	
29	(b) Persons licensed by the Contractors Licensing Board shall not be	
30	required to submit to written examination by the committee but must meet all	
31	other requirements for licensure as a residential building contractor.	
32	(c) A property owner who acts as a residential building contractor for	
33	the purpose of constructing his or her own residence is not required to be	
34	licensed under this subchapter unless the person constructs more than one (1)	
35	residence per calendar year.	
36	(b)(1) Until June 30, 2012, the committee shall waive the written	

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1	examination for a person who submits proof of:	
2	(A) Having obtained five (5) building permits within the	
3	three (3) years preceding the date of application;	
4	(B) Having obtained one (1) building permit within the	
5	preceding twelve (12) months; or	
6	(C) Experience in construction acceptable to the	
7	<u>committee.</u>	
8	(2) Subsection (b)(1) of this section does not apply to	
9	applicants for residential building contractor.	
10		
11	SECTION 10. Arkansas Code § 17-25-510 is amended to read as follows:	
12	17-25-510. Hearings regarding violations.	
13	<u>(a)</u> The Residential Building Contractors Committee may conduct	
14	hearings regarding alleged violations of this subchapter or regulations	
15	promulgated thereunder, and the hearings shall be conducted in accordance	
16	with the Arkansas Administrative Procedure Act, § 25-15-201 et seq. The	
17	committee shall within a reasonable time make findings and determinations as	
18	a result of the hearings.	
19	(b) A contractor who, after notice and hearing, is found to have	
20	committed the following actions shall pay to the Contractors Licensing Board	
21	a civil penalty of not less than one hundred dollars (\$100) nor more than	
22	four hundred dollars (\$400) for each day that any of the following violations	
23	<u>occurred:</u>	
24	(1) Using a contractor in violation of this chapter;	
25	(2) Presenting or filing the license certificate of another;	
26	(3) Given false or forged evidence of any kind to the board in	
27	obtaining a certificate of license;	
28	(4) Using an expired or revoked certificate of license;	
29	(5) Giving false or fraudulent evidence of a contractor's	
30	license to another person or entity; or	
31	(6) Committing other violations under this chapter.	
32	(c) The committee may revoke the certificate of license of any	
33	contractor licensed under this subchapter who is found guilty of:	
34	(1) Fraud or deceit in obtaining a license;	
35	(2) Aiding or abetting another contractor or person to violate	
36	<u>this chapter; or</u>	

1	(3) Gross negligence, incompetence, or misconduct in the	
2	contractor's business.	
3		
4	SECTION 11. Arkansas Code § 17-25-511 is amended to read as follows:	
5	17-25-511. Appeal from committee decision.	
6	Any person aggrieved by an action or decision of the Residential	
7	Building Contractors Committee may appeal to the Contractors Licensing Board	
8	within ten (10) calendar days after the action or decision under procedures	
9	prescribed by the board. Aggrieved parties shall be granted an opportunity to	
10	address the board regarding the committee's actions, and the final actions of	
11	the board shall be binding upon the committee.	
12		
13	SECTION 12. Arkansas Code § 17-25-512 is amended to read as follows:	
14	17-25-512. Expiration of license Fees.	
15	All licenses issued by the Contractors Licensing Board shall expire one	
16	(1) year after the date of issuance unless otherwise provided by the	
17	Residential Building Contractors Committee. The committee may charge	
18	reasonable examination fees and delinquency fees and may charge a fee not to	
19	exceed one hundred dollars (\$100) for new licenses or renewal of a license.	
20	All fees and other moneys collected by the committee shall be disposed of as	
21	provided by § 17-25-205 and shall be used by the board to implement this	
22	subchapter.	
23		
24	SECTION 13. Arkansas Code § 17-25-513 is amended to read as follows:	
25	17-25-513. Exemption for personal homebuilder Exemptions.	
26	Nothing in this subchapter shall be construed as requiring a person who	
27	acts as a residential building contractor in the construction of his or her	
28	own residence to obtain a license from the Residential Building Contractors	
29	Gommittee unless the person builds more than one (1) residence during any	
30	year.	
31	The following shall be exempted from the licensing requirements of this	
32	subchapter:	
33	(1) A person who acts as a residential building contractor in	
34	the construction of his or her residence unless he or she builds more than	
35	<u>one (1) residence during any calendar year;</u>	
36	(2) The owner of a single-family residence acting as his or her	

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1	own home improvement contractor on his or her own property;
2	(3)(A) A person or entity acting as a residential building
3	contractor or a home improvement contactor on any project, when the cost of
4	the work done or to be done does not exceed twenty thousand dollars
5	<u>(\$20,000).</u>
6	(B) Subdivision (3)(A) of this section does not apply to a
7	project in which the construction work necessary to complete the project is
8	divided into separate contracts of amounts less than twenty thousand dollars
9	<u>(\$20,000);</u>
10	(4) A subcontractor of a contractor licensed by the Residential
11	<u>Contractors Committee; and</u>
12	(5) A person or entity licensed as a contractor by another
13	licensing agency, board, or commission of the State of Arkansas if the
14	contractor is performing work within the scope of the license held by the
15	person or entity.
16	
17	SECTION 14. Arkansas Code 17-25-514 is amended to read as follows:
18	17-25-514. Workers' compensation required.
19	(a) A residential building contractor required to be licensed by the
20	Residential Building Contractors Committee <u>as a residential building</u>
21	contractor or home improvement contractor shall secure the payment of
22	workers' compensation under § 11-9-401 et seq.
23	(b) The committee shall require proof of current workers' compensation
24	coverage before issuing or renewing a license <u>as a residential building</u>
25	contractor or home improvement contractor.
26	(c)(1) If a contractor fails to maintain workers' compensation
27	coverage or fails to maintain proof of current workers' compensation coverage
28	<u>on file with the committee</u> , the committee shall revoke the contractor's
29	license.
30	(2) A contractor's license that has been revoked due to failure
31	to maintain workers' compensation coverage may be reinstated upon receipt of
32	proof that the contractor has secured workers' compensation coverage.
33	(d) The committee shall promulgate rules necessary to enforce this
34	section.
