- 13 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law and except as provided
- 14 in this subchapter, any a person, entity, or plan that provides coverage in
- 15 this state for medical, surgical, chiropractic, physical therapy, speech
- 16 pathology, audiology, professional mental health, dental, hospital, or
- 17 optometric expenses, whether the coverage is by direct payment,
- 18 reimbursement, or otherwise, shall be presumed to be subject to the
- 19 jurisdiction of the State Insurance Department and to all other applicable
- 20 provisions of the Arkansas Insurance Code unless the person, entity, or plan
- 21 described in this section shows that it is not subject to the jurisdiction of
- 22 the department.
- 23 (b) This subchapter shall does not apply to:
- 24 (1) A trust established under §§ 14-54-101 and 25-20-104 to
- 25 provide benefits such as accident and health benefits, death benefits, dental
- 26 benefits, and disability income benefits <u>if:</u>
