## For An Act To Be Entitled

an act to require a criminal background check by a PRIVATE BUSINESS THAT PROVIDES SHORT-TERM CHILD CARE FACILITIES FOR ITS PATRONS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO REQUIRE A CRIMINAL BACKGROUND CHECK BY A PRIVATE BUSINESS THAT PROVIDES SHORTTERM CHILD CARE FACILITIES FOR ITS PATRONS .

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 20, Chapter 78, Subchapter 1 is amended to add a new section to read as follows:

20-78-107. Criminal background checks for employees of private businesses that provide short-term child care for patrons.
(a) A private business that provides short-term child care for its patrons shall perform a criminal history check with the Department of Arkansas State Police and a Child Maltreatment Central Registry check with the Department of Human Services for every employee that is employed in a capacity that directly or indirectly relates to providing care or supervision of any child.
(b) Employees who have pleaded guilty or nolo contendere to or have been found guilty of an offense for which registration under the Sex Offender Registration Act of 1997 , § $12-12-901$ et seq., is required shall be prohibited from having any direct or indirect contact with or performing duties that directly or indirectly relate to providing care or supervision of
a child who is in short-term child care provided by the private business for its patrons.
