5	development regarding parental involvement, is amended to read as follows:		
6	(a) The State Board of Education's Standards for Accreditation of		
7	Arkansas Public Schools and School Districts shall require:		
8	(1) No fewer than two (2) hours of professional development		
9	opportunities every three (3) years, for teachers, which may be included in		
10	the minimum number of hours of professional development required, designed to		
11	enhance understanding of effective parental involvement strategies; and		
12	(2) No fewer than three (3) two (2) hours of professional		
13	development opportunities every three (3) years for administrators, in		
14	addition to the minimum number of hours of professional development required,		
15	designed to enhance understanding of:		
16	(A) Effective parent involvement strategies; and		
17	(B) The importance of administrative leadership in setting		
18	expectations and creating a climate conducive to parental participation.		
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20	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 6-17-703(a), concerning in-service training		
21	for Arkansas history, is amended to add an additional section to read as
