3	(2) Twenty-six (26) programs, initiatives, and constitutional	
4	issues be given priority consideration as being key to competitiveness and

9	economic development is ever-changing and the continuing review will provide

20	15-3-503. Arkansas Acceleration Fund Committee.	
21	(a) The Arkansas Science and Technology Authority shall create the	
22	Arkansas Acceleration Fund Committee.	
23	(b)(1) The committee shall make recommendations regarding support and	
24	assistance for the accelerated growth of knowledge-based and high-technology	
25	jobs in the State of Arkansas through focused funding of the state's	
26	initiatives and programs.	
27	(2) For funds in the Arkansas Acceleration Fund, § 19-5-1243,	
28	the committee shall make recommendations to the authority regarding the	
29	allocation or re-allocation of funds and moneys for programs and initiatives	
30	authorized by the:	
31	(A) Arkansas Research Alliance Act, § 15-3-301 et seq.;	
32	(B) Innovate Arkansas Fund, § 19-5-1237;

7	15-3-504. Members of the committee.	
8	(a) The committee is composed of the following members:	
9	(1) Seven (7) of the members shall be individuals from the	
10	private sector;	
11	(2) One (1) member to be the president of the Arkansas Science	
12	and Technology Authority or the president's designee;	
13	(3) One (1) member to be the executive director of the Arkansas	
14	Economic Development Commission or the executive director's designee; and	
15	(4) One (1) member to be the president of Arkansas Development	
16	Finance Authority or the president's designee.	
17	(b) Each private sector member of the committee shall:	
18	(1) Be knowledgeable through personal experience or training of	
19	the process of growth and development of knowledge-based or technology-based	
20	jobs;	
21	(2) Have obtained at least an undergraduate degree from a four-	
22	year institution of higher learning; and	
23	(3) Have:	
24	(A) A science or engineering degree from a four-year	
25	institution of higher learning;	
26	(B) Experience managing a private sector knowledge-based	
27	or high technology company; or	
28	(C) Experience working in areas related to development of	
29	private sector knowledge-based or high technology jobs.	
30	(c)(l) The president of the Arkansas Science and Technology Authority	
31	shall seek recommendations from the authority's board of directors and the	
32	Governor of the State of Arkansas for the initial list of private sector	
33	committee members.	
34	(2) After obtaining the recommendations, the president of the	
35	Arkansas Science and Technology Authority shall nominate the initial private	
36	sector members of the committee for appointment to the committee by the	

T	authority's board of directors.
2	(d)(1) Each private sector committee member shall serve a four-year
3	term, with a maximum of two (2) consecutive four-year terms.
4	(2) The initial terms of the private sector committee members
5	shall be as follows:
6	(A) One (1) member shall serve a one-year term;
7	(B) Two (2) members shall serve a two-year term;
8	(C) Two (2) members shall serve a three-year term; and
9	(D) Two (2) members shall serve a four-year term.
10	(3) The president of the Arkansas Science and Technology
11	Authority shall determine the terms of the initial private members of the
12	<pre>committee.</pre>
13	(4) Each member may be reappointed from time to time thereafter
14	to serve not more than a maximum of eight (8) consecutive years including his
15	or her initial term.
16	(e) Successors to the initial private sector committee members shall
17	be nominated by the president of the Arkansas Science and Technology
18	Authority upon recommendation by the committee and shall be appointed by the
19	board of directors of the Arkansas Science and Technology Authority.
20	(f) Members of the committee shall serve without compensation.
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22	15-3-505. Recommendations.
23	(a) Upon receiving funding, the Arkansas Acceleration Fund Committee
24	shall meet at least annually to recommend the allocation and priorities of
25	funding, funding ratios, and the maximum amounts to be made available among
26	the particular programs to be supported under this chapter and that will
27	accelerate the development of knowledge-based and high technology jobs in
28	Arkansas.
29	(b) The committee may base its recommendations for investment and
30	reinvestment on an analysis of the growth in the state's knowledge-based and
31	high-technology jobs and associated wages and estimated individual state
32	income tax revenue.
33	(c) The committee's recommendations may be used to guide the
34	preparation of budget requests by the Arkansas Science and Technology
35	Authority or budget requests by state agencies for the programs stated in §
36	15-3-503(b).

1	(d)(1) The Board of Directors of the Arkansas Science and Technology
2	Authority may act on the committee's recommendations.
3	(2) The governing body of each agency listed under § 15-3-503(b)
4	may act on the committee's recommendations for the programs listed in their
5	areas.
6	(3) The board shall report its actions to the Governor by June
7	30 of each year and shall forward copies of the report to the agencies
8	included in the report's recommendations.

10	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 19, Chapter 5, Subchapter 12 is amended
11	to add an additional section to read as follows:
12	19-5-1243. Arkansas Acceleration Fund.
13	(a) There is created on the books of the Treasurer of State, the
14	Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a miscellaneous
15	fund to be known as the "Arkansas Acceleration Fund".
16	(b) The fund shall consist of:
17	(1) Funds provided by law; and
18	(2) Grants made by any person or federal government agency.
19	(c) The fund shall be used by the Arkansas Science and Technology
20	Authority to provide support and assistance for the accelerated growth of
21	knowledge-based and high-technology jobs in the State of Arkansas through
22	focused funding of the state initiatives and programs as defined under § 15-
23	<u>3-501 et seq.</u>
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
