17	SECTION 2. DO NOT CODIFY. <u>(a) By August 1, 2011, the Director of the</u>		
18	Department of Workforce Services shall seek a determination from the United		
19	States Secretary of Labor as to whether § 11-10-724 complies with federal		
20	law.		
21	(b) If the secretary determines that § 11-10-724 complies with federal		
22	law, then the director shall promulgate rules to implement this section.		
23	(c) If the secretary determines that § 11-10-724 does not comply with		
24	federal law, then the director shall seek a waiver from the secretary that		
25	will permit the implementation of this section and establish the credit upon		
26	the granting of the waiver.

28	SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
29	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that Arkansas has a high percentage		
30	of unemployed residents; that encouraging the creation of jobs would decrease		
31	the unemployment rate in Arkansas; that the ideal time to make changes to the		
32	unemployment laws is at the beginning of a calendar quarter; and that this		
33	act is necessary to encourage the creation of jobs and the hiring of		
34	unemployed persons. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this		
35	act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and		
36	<u>safety shall become effective on July 1, 2011.</u>
