9 EDUCATION FOR STUDENTS WHO ARE SIXTEEN, SEVENTEEN, OR

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17 *TO PROVIDE FUNDING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF*

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25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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27 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 20, Subchapter 1, is amended*
28 *to add an additional section to read as follows:*

29 *6-20-108. Funding for students enrolled in an adult education program.*

30 *(a) On July 1, 2012, and annually thereafter on July 1, the Department*
31 *of Education shall transfer to the Department of Career Education from the*
32 *Public School Fund an amount equal to one thousand six hundred dollars*
33 *(\$1,600) for each student:*

34 *(1) Who by January 31 of the preceding school year enrolled in*
35 *an adult education program under § 6-18-201(b); and*

36 *(2) For whom the school district has signed the waiver required*



1 under § 6-18-201(b).

2 (b) A student who is counted for funding under this section also shall
3 be counted in the school district's average daily membership through the
4 fourth quarter of the school year.

5 (c) A student who enrolls in an adult education program on or after
6 February 1 shall not be counted in that school year either:

7 (1) For the school district's third quarter average daily
8 membership from the date after the student enrolls in the adult education
9 program; or

10 (2) For the funding under this section.

11 (d) In a school year that a student is released from the adult
12 education program and reenrolls in public school:

13 (1) The school district shall count the student in its average
14 daily membership based on the date the student reenrolls; and

15 (2) The Department of Career Education shall not count the
16 student for funding under this section.

17 (e) The Department of Career Education shall use the funding provided
18 for under this section to support the adult education programs of the
19 Department of Career Education.

20 (f) The per-student funding amount under this section shall be
21 increased or decreased at the same proportional rate as the per-student
22 foundation funding amount under § 6-20-2305.
