## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR HUMAN SERVICES WORKERS IN THE SCHOOLS; TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR HUMAN SERVICES WORKERS IN THE SCHOOLS AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-76-112(d)(1), concerning the Department of Human Services workers in schools, is amended to read as follows:
(d) (1) Funding for human services workers shall be targeted to schools with ninety percent ( $90 \%$ ) eighty percent $(80 \%$ ) or more of their children eligible for the National School Lunch Program Free and Reduced Lunch Program under the National School Lunch Act.

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that there is a need for a human services workers program in schools and that this act is immediately necessary because most schools lack the expertise to provide appropriate services to students and because there is a need to inform schools about the availability of the program prior to the end of the current school year to have the opportunity to recruit a sufficient number of human services workers for the next school year. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and

this act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on April 15, 2011.
