an act to amend arkansas Law to clarify the duties of STATE AGENCIES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

 TO CLARIFY THE DUTIES OF STATE AGENCIES.```
BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 21, Chapter 12, Subchapter 1 is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

21-12-104. Employment relationship between state agency and state employee.
(a) A state agency may discharge or terminate a state employee, not otherwise bound by a valid written contract of employment for a term of employment, for good cause shown or for any reason that has a rational basis and that does not violate state or federal law or public policy.
(b) (l) Before or at the time of discharge or termination of a state employee, a state agency shall provide to the state employee a written notice containing the reason for the discharge or termination.
(2) (A) The written notice required under this subsection shall contain the following:
(i) The termination date and time; and
(ii) The primary reason for the discharge or
termination.
(B) The failure to state in the written notice a cause for the discharge or termination of the state employee creates a rebuttable presumption that there was not a good-faith basis for the discharge or
termination of the state employee.
(c) This section shall not apply to an institution of higher education.
