15 TO REQUIRE A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER TO  
16 COMPLETE CONTINUING EDUCATION AND  
17 TRAINING RELATING TO PERSONS WITH  
18 DISABILITIES IN A LAW ENFORCEMENT

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
23

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 12, Chapter 9, Subchapter 1 is amended  
25 to add a new section to read as follows:

26 12-9-116. Persons with disabilities training.

27 (a)(1) In accordance with the certification requirements of the  
28 Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training for law  
29 enforcement officers, all law enforcement officers in the state shall  
30 complete annual continuing education of at least six (6) hours of training  
31 relating to persons with disabilities in a law enforcement context.

32 (2) Practicum training shall also be sufficient for the  
33 requirement under subdivision (a)(1) of this section.

34 (b) Training under subsection (a) of this section shall include  
35 without limitation:

36 (1) The dynamics of relating to a person with a disability;

- 2                   (3) Available supportive services; and
- 3                   (4) Pro-arrest guidelines and drawbacks of dual arrest and
- 4 practices to promote the safety of law enforcement officers.
