PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO PROHIBIT A CITY OR TOWN FROM ANNEXING
INTERSTATE HIGHWAYS OR STATE HIGHWAYS TO
GENERATE REVENUE FROM TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is to prohibit a city or town from
annexing interstate highways or state highways to generate revenue from
traffic violations; and for other purposes.
